The Flood & Ark for Today

- 1) God is patient, but we aren't promised tomorrow
- 2) God promises judgment for sin - our sin will drown us & lead to death
- 3) God offers deliverance & rescue through His salvation
- 4) God's call is for us to stand firm, even alone, as we are obedient to follow His call on our lives.

Our Response:

1. According to Hebrews 11:7, Noah acted “by faith.” What does faith-filled obedience look like in everyday life?
2. Noah was called a “preacher of righteousness” in 2 Peter 2:5. How can Christians lovingly speak truth in a culture resistant to God? What does Noah’s willingness to stand alone teach about courage and conviction?
3. What can we learn from Noah obeying God’s detailed instructions for the ark? Why is obedience especially important when God’s instructions don’t fully make sense to us?
4. What fears or questions do you think Noah may have faced while building the ark?
5. How does God’s patience before the flood reveal both His mercy and His justice? What does God’s patience in the days of Noah teach us about His mercy today?
6. In what ways do people today ignore God’s warnings like the people before the flood? Why is it dangerous to assume there will always be more time to repent and follow God?
7. How can faith help believers continue obeying God during long seasons of waiting? What specific area of obedience may God be calling you to act on immediately?
8. What does God’s compassion toward Noah teach us about His desire to save people?
