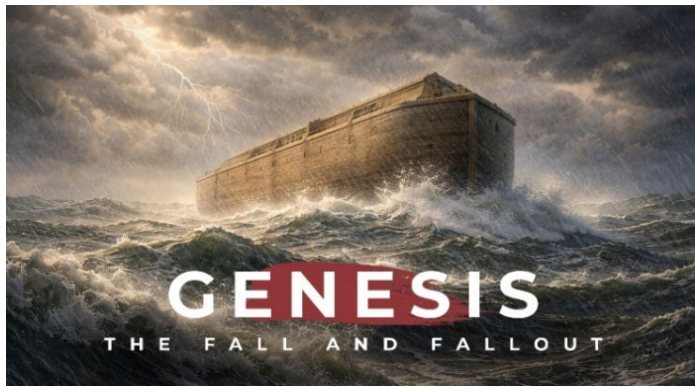
The Carryout

- 1) The Lord is in control of human history & the universe. Nothing & no one can stop Him or His perfect plan.
- 2) The Lord is always opposed to our pride & only uses humble people.

- 3) Our desire should be to live for the glory of His name & not our own.
- 4) The Lord's discipline or judgment is designed to protect us & not harm us.

Our Response:

1. What does this passage teach us about the limits of human achievement apart from God?
2. The very thing the builders at Babel sought to prevent by building the tower (being scattered) was in fact the result of their actions. What's another example of how sin can cause what we hoped to prevent?
3. What does Babel reveal about humanity's sinful tendency toward self-exaltation? In what ways was pride at the root of their actions?
4. In what ways are people still trying to "make a name" for themselves today? What accomplishments or achievements are you tempted to use to gain significance?
5. How can pride quietly but destructively influence our service, ministry, career, or family life?
6. What is the difference between seeking God's glory and seeking our own recognition? What practical steps can you take this week to pursue God's glory rather than your own reputation?
