#### Read Job 1

**Authentic**: (1) not false or copied; genuine; real; (2) genuine, real, share the sense of actuality and lack of falsehood or misrepresentation. It carries the connotation of authoritative confirmation that things or people are what they are claimed or appear to be (3) having an origin supported by unquestionable evidence; verified (4) representing one's true nature or beliefs; true to oneself or to the person identified

### Read Job 2

## A clear picture of authenticity - Job

- 1) A person who has <u>integrity</u> Matthew 5:6-12; 1 Timothy 4:11-16
- 2) A person who is consistent I Peter 1:7; I Timothy 4:6-12
- 3) A person who is vulnerable Romans 7:14-25; 2 Corinthians 12:7-10
- 4) A person whom you could imitate 1 Corinthians 11:1; Hebrews 13:7
- 5) A person who is humble Matthew 11:29; Luke 14:11; 1 Peter 5:5-6
- 6) A person who is accountable Ecclesiastes 4:9-12; James 5:13-16

# A clear picture of hypocrisy – Pharisees Matthew 23:1-36

- 1) A person who is counterfeit
- 2) A person who is changing
- 3) A person who is <u>closed</u>
- 4) A person who is <u>corrupt</u>
- 5) A person who is prideful
- 6) A person who walks <u>alone</u>
