7. He gave with the right motive

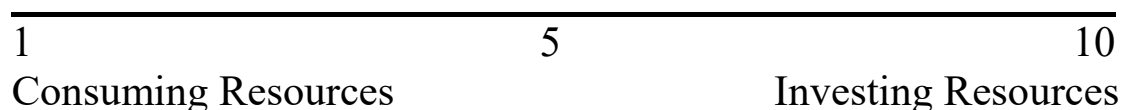
What does it look like for you to live faithfully?

1. Start with your heart – be willing & available
2. Start attending regularly – be here consistently
3. Start serving – find a place to serve
4. Start giving – take the next step up the generosity ladder
5. Start taking account – Answer the question: Are you investing or consuming?

- 2) I am giving/tithing on a regular basis
- 3) I am giving of my time by attending consistently
