Read Acts 2:22-36 **Peter chose to live an evangelistic life**

- 1) He was a <u>changed</u> (transformed) life
- 2) He was concerned & compassionate burdened
- 3) He was convinced of the truth of the Gospel
- 4) He was <u>convicted</u> he must share
- 5) He was <u>courageous</u>
- 6) He <u>captured</u> the moments
- 7) He clearly communicated the Gospel
- 8) He <u>challenged</u> others to accept Christ
- 9) He was committed to the next steps (to disciple them)

What did it look like for us to live evangelistically?

- 1) We need to be <u>burdened</u> to share
- 2) We need to be <u>prepared</u> to share
- 3) We need to be investing in relationships
- 4) We need to be inviting others to Jesus and to church
- 5) We need to be investing in & <u>influencing</u> others (making disciples)
