Read Acts 2:22-36

Peter chose to live an evangelistic life

- 1) He was a changed (transformed) life
- 2) He was concerned & compassionate burdened
- 3) He was convinced of the truth of the Gospel
- 4) He was convicted he must share
- 5) He was courageous
- 6) He captured the moments
- 7) He clearly communicated the Gospel
- 8) He challenged others to accept Christ
- 9) He was committed to the next steps (to disciple them)

What did it look like for us to live evangelistically?

- 1) We need to be burdened to share
- 2) We need to be prepared to share
- 3) We need to be investing in relationships
