

THINGS JESUS NEVER SAID "I Won't Give You More Than You Can Handle" Matthew 14:22-33 March 30, 2025

What Jesus Never Said...

- \checkmark I won't give you more than you can handle
- \checkmark I won't allow you to get in over your head
- \checkmark I won't allow or bring too many difficult situations into your life
- \checkmark I don't want you to ever be overwhelmed or feel helpless at times
- \checkmark I don't won't you to struggle or wrestle with overwhelming moments
- \checkmark I don't want you to have to depend on anyone but yourself

What Did Jesus Really Say...

- I will not allow you to be <u>tempted</u> beyond what you are able 1 Corinthians 10:13
- I will give you more than handle so you will look to Me & not trust in yourself or others Exodus 14:13-14; 2 Chronicles 20:15,17; Isaiah 41:10
- I will <u>allow</u> & even <u>send</u> you into storms so you will learn more about Me & yourself Matthew 14:22, 28-32
- I will deepen your faith and trust in Me during & after these moments Matthew 13:32-33; John 6:21
- Though I may let you struggle for a season, it will not last <u>forever</u>. Psalm 30:5; Mark 6:48
- Even though you can't see me, I see you. I'm always there & I will never walk away Mark 6:48
- I am praying & interceding for you always Matthew 14:23; Luke 22:31-32; Romans 8:34; Hebrews 7:25
- I will <u>never</u> let go of you, even when you sink <u>Matthew 14:30-31</u>

What Do We Do?

1) Most often, it's after the storm before we truly see & understand what the Lord is doing and what He's trying to show us

- 2) We need to learn to trust Him there's a reason for the storm and be looking for Him to work and move in amazing ways
- 3) We need to be reminded that He sees, hears, and knows & is interceding for us to the Father
- 4) Our response should be to worship & adore Jesus during & after the storm Job 2:20-22
