The Cowardly

- 1) They deserted Jesus
- 2) Peter denied Jesus
- 3) They doubted Jesus
- 4) They disappeared

Read 3:12-26; 4:8-12

The Courageous

- 1) They threw <u>caution</u> to the wind
- 2) They were confident in Christ Acts 4:13; Ephesians 6:19; Philippians 1:20
- 3) They were <u>convicted</u> and <u>convinced</u> Romans 8:37-39; 2 Timothy 1:12; 3:14
- 4) They confronted the people with the truth
- 5) They were compelled to clearly & convincingly share the gospel

The Transformation

- 1) They were changed Romans 1:16
- 2) They counted the cost Luke 14:28; Matthew 16:24-26
- 3) They considered it a privilege to be worthy to suffer Acts 5:40-42
- 4) Our <u>choice</u> and <u>challenge</u> 2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 4:22–24; Colossians 3:1–3
