## **Real Life in Step\***

Teen Breakout Session

A Reflective Moment to Discern the Spirit's Leading

In Mark 8, when Jesus heals the blind man, his sight doesn't come back all at once—clarity comes gradually. In the same way, spiritual growth often begins with partial vision. We learn the disciplines, we practice them, but transformation takes time. Through this guided session, attendees will reflect on where the Holy Spirit may be leading by paying attention to the presence—or absence—of the fruit of the Spirit in their lives. Rather than striving to manufacture change, we'll explore self-examination and confession like never before.
