2. Are there people I'm judging? What is the root cause of that judgment? How do I stop my judgment and repent before God and others?
  
3. When I pray, am I praying for God's glory or for mine? What do my prayers reveal about my priorities?
  
4. In what areas am I not submitting to God? In what areas do I need to resist the devil?
