To understand generosity, we need to understand God's sovereignty.

God's sovereignty means...

- I. He is worthy of worship and reverence (50:1-6)
- II. He owns everything and needs nothing (50:7-15)
- III. He alone has the right to tell us how to live (50:16-21)
- IV. He alone can offer salvation (50:22-23)

- 1. Give your life to Jesus. Discover God's salvation.
- 2. Reflect on God's power, holiness, and might.
- 3. Invite people into your life to challenge you and keep you from making God into *your* image.
- 4. Reflect on your generosity. Is it in response to who God is or because you think God needs you?
