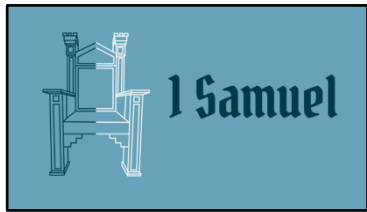

1 Samuel 1:1 – 2:11
