- III. It's foolish to forget the Lord. It's wise to trust Him.
(25:23-31; Prov. 3:7)
- IV. It's foolish to reject correction. It's wise to accept it.
(25:32-35; Prov. 9:8-9)
- V. Foolishness leads to death. Wisdom leads to life.
(25:36-42; Prov. 10:27)
