## MISSION

At All Saints', we believe all children and youth are born musicians with a worthy voice. Our mission is to help them discover and nurture that voice through an immersive, non-competitive program of musical study within a safe, spiritual, and intergenerational community.

Choir is a team where every child and youth is valued, cared for, and essential. All are invited to learn, serve, and sing—offering their gifts cooperatively and wholeheartedly to God. There is no “bench”—each singer plays an active role from rehearsal to worship. Through music, we foster spiritual formation, build community, and walk together in faith.

## BELONGING & LEARNING

Our Children and Youth Choirs have a place for every child and youth from PreK (4 years old) to 12th Grade. Membership at All Saints' is not a requirement for participation.

Youth and children learn that church is a welcoming space to build lasting friendships in a fun, safe, and positive environment. They explore songs of our faith and heritage, develop their voices, discover the joy of singing together, and grow essential musical skills. Every young member is valued as an important part of the worship community, with unique gifts to share.

## ABOUT OUR CHOIRS

### Youth Choir

*Sunday evenings*

Handbells 4:15-5:00 p.m.

Choir 5:00-6:00 p.m.

Our Youth Choir (grades 7-12) sings meaningful music across styles and eras, drawing members from over 20 schools across Atlanta. We rehearse weekly, sing during Sunday worship, take an annual out-of-town trip, and often combine with other All Saints' choirs.

Youth Choir is that bridge between childhood and adulthood, and our mission is to cultivate artistry that inspires our music and shapes more compassionate, loving, hopeful, tender, and expressive individuals.

### Junior Choir

*Wednesday evenings*

Choir 5:15-6:00 p.m.

Handbells 6:00-6:30 p.m.

Our Junior Choir (grades 3-6) performs hymns, descants, and a diverse selection of repertoire. Members develop skills in singing harmony, sight-reading, and singing in foreign languages, all while cultivating vocal artistry. A key focus is connecting our music to the themes of the church year.

The choir sings during Sunday worship, Christmas Eve (with the Primary Choir), the St. Nicholas Celebration, Ash Wednesday for All Ages, and Palm Sunday. They also present the Annual Children's Musical each February.

## ABOUT OUR CHOIRS

### Primary Choir

*Wednesday evenings*

4:35-5:10 p.m.

Our Primary Choir (grades 1-2) learns music literacy skills through games, movement, and folk songs, developing their singing voices, and various repertoire from age-appropriate sacred songs and hymns. They sing at Sunday services, Harry Potter Night, Christmas Eve (with Junior Choir), Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday, and in the Annual Children's Musical each February.

### Cherub Choir

*Wednesday evenings*

4:00-4:30 p.m.

Our Cherub Choir (PreK-K) develops music literacy through singing, movement, steady beat, vocal exploration, and early note and rhythm games. They perform occasional preludes at the 9:00 a.m. service, Children's Church, Harry Potter Night, the Christmas Pageant, Shrove Tuesday, and Sunday services.

## EPISCOPAL & BEYOND

The basis of our repertoire is the Episcopal choral canon and liturgy, including Psalm and prayer settings anthems and Bible stories. We also explore the broader repertoire of the Christian faith, spanning many denominations and practices. In addition, we draw from musical traditions around the world and across genres and styles, all thoughtfully chosen to reflect the full tapestry of God's community, world, and creation.
