
Book Studies




Women's Zoom Book Study

Thursdays at 10:30 am on Zoom

Our church has a group of women who have been meeting on Thursday mornings, 10:30-11:30 am, on Zoom since Covid kept us from meeting in person more than four years ago. We have continued on Zoom even though we are no longer prevented from meeting in person. We find it's easier to quickly click onto a Zoom meeting than it is having to get dressed and drive somewhere.

We've had nearly 20 participants through the years with several of us volunteering to lead a wide variety of books, including Jesus Calling by Sarah Young, Love is the Way by Bishop Michael Curry, Soul Feast by Marjorie Thompson, Unshakable Hope by Max Lucado, Feathers of Hope by Sharon Garlough Brown, The Cup of Our Life by Joyce Rupp, An Altar in the World by Barbara Brown Taylor, Sacred Rhythms by Ruth Haley Barton, Before Amen by Max Lucado, Freeing Jesus by Diana Butler Bass, A Lineage of Grace by Francine Rivers, and No Wonder They Call Him the Savior by Max Lucado. We've found each of us have different preferences, but that we are free to give our differing viewpoints and can benefit from all of them.



Our next study will be of the book, Holy Moments, written by Matthew Kelly and led by Rev. Bridget Waddell, Pastor of the Chickamauga, GA Presbyterian Church. In this practical, simple-but-profoundly-written little book, Kelly helps us see how we can receive "holy moments" by choosing to make right decisions that transform our lives from this point forward.
