GO FOR a Walk

Find a place outside to read the Bible story (reverse side) with your child. Invite your child to go on a walk with you. Recall that John walked through the countryside telling people that Jesus was coming.

TALK About Jesus

MAKE a Jesus Collage

Mention that John traveled around telling people about Jesus (see reverse side). Say that John told that Jesus was coming and that He would show people how to live the way God wants. Write *Jesus* in different sizes on paper and cut apart. Guide your child to glue the names to a paper plate. Allow your child to color on the plate. Pray, thanking God for Jesus. Let your child display her plate as a reminder that Jesus helps her know how to live.

Repeat the name of Jesus often. Look at pictures of Jesus. Talk about the things Jesus did. Thank God for Jesus.


John Taught About Jesus

God had a special job for John. God wanted him to tell people about Jesus.




John did what God planned for him to do. He taught people about Jesus.



John Baptized People

LUKE 3:1-22; JOHN 1:29-34

John the Baptist had a special mission: to tell people that Jesus was coming! John traveled around the area of the Jordan River and urged people to turn away from their sins. John helped people follow what God said. John preached, "Share your possessions! Be honest. Be satisfied with what you have."

John also told people about Scriptures that Isaiah wrote many years before. Isaiah said that God would send Someone to save everyone.

As the people listened to John, they wondered if he was the Messiah—the One whom they had been waiting for and who would save them. But John explained that he was not the Messiah. John told them, "Someone is coming who is more powerful than I am. I am not worthy to untie His sandals!"

Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River. When Jesus came up from the water, the skies opened. God's Holy Spirit came down like a dove to Jesus. A voice from heaven said, "This is My beloved Son. I am pleased with Him!"

Later when John saw Jesus coming toward him, John said to the crowd, "Here is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! He is the One I told you about."

John said, "I saw the Spirit coming down from heaven like a dove and rested on Him. I have seen and testified that He is the Son of God."
