## WRITE with Sidewalk Chalk

Go outside with your toddler. Encourage your child to draw on the sidewalk or driveway with sidewalk chalk. Write the words *Peter* and *Jesus*. Mention that Peter wrote letters to tell people about Jesus and that they should make right choices. Tell your child the letters Peter wrote are part of the Bible. Look at a Bible and show your child 1 Peter and 2 Peter.

## SEND a Letter

Read the Bible story (reverse side) with your preschooler. Mention that Peter told people in churches about God and Jesus. Help your child think of someone they could tell about God. Invite your child to draw a picture to send to that person. Write on a paper *God loves you!* Help your child fold the paper and put it in an envelope. Address the envelope and add a stamp. Put the letter in a mailbox.

### 1 PETER; 2 PETER


Peter taught people about Jesus. He wrote some letters to the people he had taught.

Peter wrote, "I am writing to you who love Jesus. I want to remind you about the things that Jesus did and said so that you will remember them. Remember that the words in the Bible are not people's words; they are God's words. You should love one another and follow what Jesus taught. Keep learning about Jesus. He is our example of how we should live. This will help us make right choices."

## Peter Wrote Letters

### 1 PETER; 2 PETER

Peter was one of Jesus' disciples. After Jesus went back to heaven and the church began to grow, Peter wrote two letters to some of the believers.

Peter wrote the first letter to believers in the Roman provinces in Asia Minor. Peter wanted to encourage the believers and help them remember all the things Jesus and God had done for them.

Peter encouraged his readers to remember that they have hope in Jesus. Peter challenged them to live holy lives, to love one another, to be honorable, and to choose to obey those in authority over them. Peter also wrote that wives and husbands should choose to obey God together.

Peter told the believers to be compassionate and humble and to not pay back evil for evil. He instructed them to make good choices when they faced problems. Peter challenged them to be filled with peace. He explained that God would help and support them when someone treated them poorly.

In Peter's second letter he warned believers to not believe teachers who taught things that were different than the Scriptures. Peter told the believers to make good choices so they would not be led away from Jesus. Peter also encouraged them to follow what the Scriptures said, and he taught them to live the way Jesus wanted.

Peter reminded the believers that Jesus promised to return and urged them to be ready when that day came. Peter told the believers to honor God with their lives and give Him glory.
