## FEED a Crowd

Let your child gather many toy animals and dolls. Remind your child that many people came to see Jesus. Say that Jesus loved the people and gave them food because they were hungry. Guide your preschooler to tear up pieces of scrap paper and pretend it is fish and bread. Help your child pretend to feed bread to the dolls and animals.

## COUNT to Twelve

Put an empty egg carton and a bowl of fish crackers on a table. Read aloud the Bible story (reverse side) with your child. Remind your child that Jesus loved the people and wanted to give them food so they were not hungry. Help your child put one cracker in each of the spaces in the egg carton. Recall that when all the people had eaten, there were 12 baskets of fish and bread left over. Thank God for food and eat the crackers together.

## PREPARE a Meal

Tell your baby the Bible story (reverse side) as you prepare a meal. Mention how your family works together to cook the food and set the table. Comment: "Jesus ate with His helpers. He wants us to remember Him and the things He did. Thank You, God, for Jesus." Enjoy a family meal together.



### Babies

### 2s

Jesus wanted to have a special supper with His helpers. Jesus told the helpers, "Go to the city and find a man. Tell him I want to have a meal at his house."

The helpers did what Jesus said. When they found the man, they followed him to his house. The helpers got the meal ready.

Jesus and His helpers went to the house. Jesus sat at the table. He gave all His helpers bread. Then He gave them something to drink. Jesus said, "Remember Me."

After supper, Jesus and His friends sang a song and left the house.

Jesus had a special supper with His friends. He told them things that would happen. Jesus told them to remember Him. What do you remember about Jesus?






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## A Special Supper

**MATTHEW 26:17-19,26-30;  
1 CORINTHIANS 11:17-29**

Jesus wanted His disciples (helpers) to remember Him. He planned to eat a special meal with His disciples and tell them special things to do that would help them remember Him.

Jesus' disciples came to Him and asked, "Where are we going to eat our special Passover meal?"


Jesus answered, "Go into the city. You will find a man. Say to him, 'Jesus will eat the Passover meal at your house with His disciples.'" The disciples found the man and prepared the Passover meal.

At the special supper, Jesus took the bread and thanked God. He tore the bread into pieces and gave some to each disciple. Jesus said, "Take this bread and eat it. Eat this bread and remember Me."

Jesus took a cup and thanked God. Jesus passed the cup to the disciples and said, "Drink from this cup; I want you to remember what I have done. Remember Me when I am not with you. Remember Me every time you eat a meal like this. Remember how much I love you."

Jesus and His disciples ate the Passover meal together. After the meal, they sang a song together. They left the room together, going out to a place to pray.





## The Last Supper

**MATTHEW 26:17-30;**  
**1 CORINTHIANS 11:17-29**

Jesus and His disciples were in Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover feast. On the first day of the celebration, Jesus gave instructions to some of His disciples about where they should prepare the Passover meal. The disciples followed Jesus' instructions and prepared the meal.



That evening while Jesus and His twelve disciples were eating, Jesus told them that one of them would soon betray Him. The disciples were upset and each of them began to ask Jesus, "I'm not the one, am I, Lord?"

Jesus explained to His disciples that He knew it was God's plan for Him to die, but the one who betrayed Him also would face bad consequences. Jesus said, "It is the one who dips his hand in the bowl with Me." Only Jesus knew that person was Judas Iscariot.

During the supper Jesus prayed, broke the bread into pieces, and gave it to the disciples. He said, "Take and eat this bread. It is My body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me."

Then Jesus took the cup and gave thanks. He passed it to the disciples and said, "Drink from this cup, all of you. It is My blood that I will pour out for you so that your sins can be forgiven. As often as you drink it, remember Me."

Jesus wanted the disciples and all believers to remember Him each time they observed this special supper. By eating the bread and drinking from the cup, people would know what Jesus did through His death until He comes again.

After Jesus and the disciples sang, they went to the Mount of Olives.
