SHOUT *Hosanna*

Read aloud the Bible story (reverse side) with your child. Mention that the people were so happy to see Jesus. Say that they put coats and palm branches on the road and shouted "Hosanna!" Give your child a scarf or small towel. Play praise music. Together, wave scarves and say: "Hosanna!"

Babies

GO FOR *a Ride*

Spread a soft blanket in the bottom of a laundry basket. Position your child on his back in the basket. Pull the basket slowly around the room. Say: "Jesus rode a donkey into Jerusalem. People were happy to see Him! Jesus is God's Son."

MAKE *a Palm Branch*

Look at the Bible story picture (reverse side). Remind your child that the people were happy to see Jesus. Say that some people put palm branches on the ground as He rode by on a donkey. Trace around your child's hand on a paper. Allow your child to color the handprint. Cut out the handprint and help her tape it onto a craft stick or straw. Encourage your child to place her palm branch on the floor and say: "Jesus is coming! Hosanna!"


Babies



DRAW A LINE between each dot to complete the picture.




COUNT Branches

MATTHEW 21:1-11; MARK 11:1-11

The disciples found the donkeys just like Jesus said and brought them to Jesus.


The disciples laid their coats on the young donkey's back so Jesus could sit on the donkey and ride him into Jerusalem.

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

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Triumphal Entry

MATTHEW 21:1-11; MARK 11:1-11

"Go into the village ahead," Jesus told two disciples as they came to the town of Bethphage. "You will find a donkey tied there. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks, you should say that the Lord needs it."

Jesus planned to enter Jerusalem riding on a donkey. This would fulfill a prophecy (word from God) that was written hundreds of years before. This prophecy said, "Look! Your King is coming, riding on a donkey."

The disciples found the donkey in the street, tied beside a door. "What are you doing? Why are you untying the donkey?" people asked. The disciples answered as Jesus had instructed them and brought the donkey to Jesus. They threw their robes over it, and Jesus climbed on.

A very large crowd was waiting for Jesus when He rode into Jerusalem. Some people spread their robes on the road. Others cut leafy branches from trees to put on the road. People in the crowd shouted, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

The whole city of Jerusalem was stirred up by Jesus' arrival. People asked, "Who is this?"

Others answered, "This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee!"
