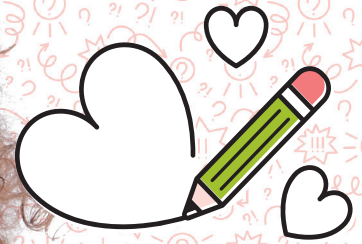
Go and tell the good news about Jesus.

### LOOK in the Bible

Open your Bible to 2 Timothy 1. Show your child as you say: "This is 2 Timothy in the Bible. It is a letter written by Paul to Timothy. Paul wrote to remind Timothy not to forget what he had been taught about Jesus." (See reverse side.)

### MAIL Letters at the Post Office

Go to the post office with your child to mail a card or letter to grandparents or other loved ones. Retell the Bible story (reverse side) as you drive together in the car.

Paul said that the Scriptures (Bible) help people know the right things to do.

### 2s

Timothy's mother and grandmother loved God and taught Timothy all about God.

Paul asked Timothy to go with him to tell people about Jesus and God.

Timothy returned home. Later Paul wrote Timothy a letter.

Paul told Timothy to remember all that he had learned about the Scriptures (Bible) and Jesus. Paul said that the Scriptures (Bible) help people know the right things to do.

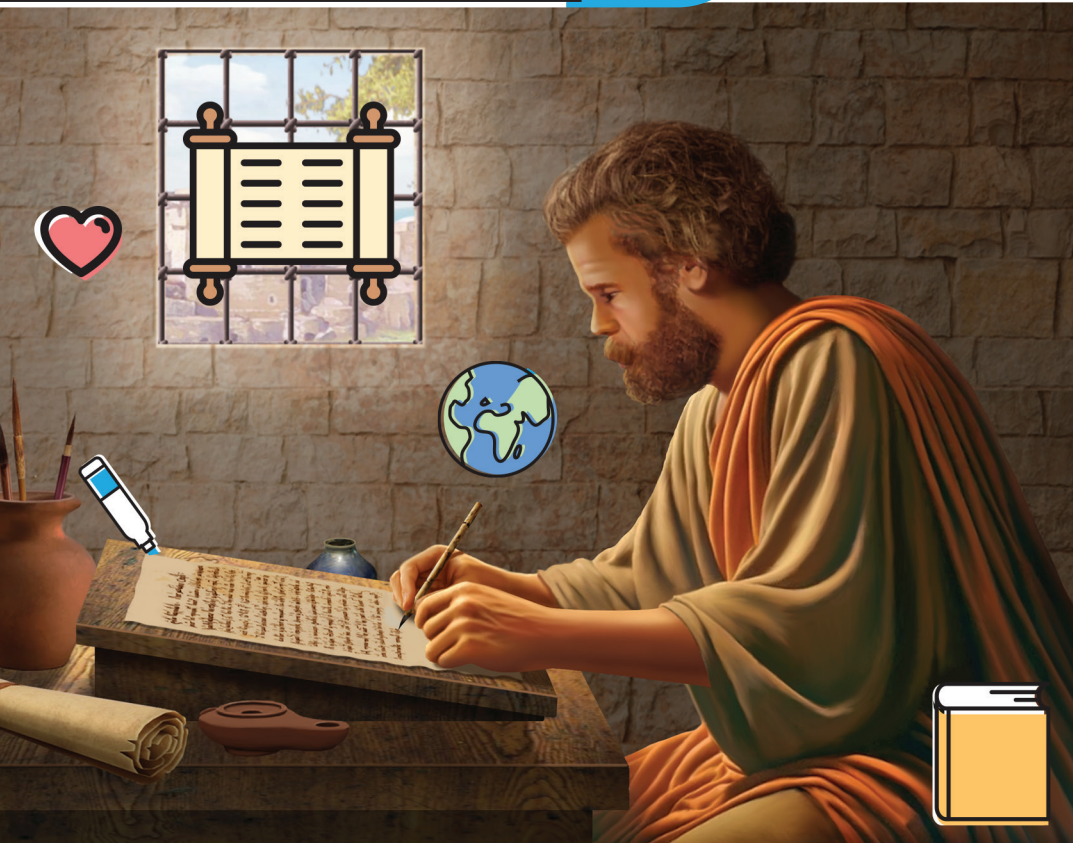

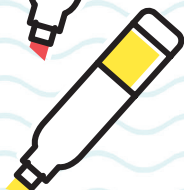

## Paul Wrote to Timothy

**BASED ON ACTS 16:1-4; 2 TIMOTHY 1:1-5; 3:14-17**

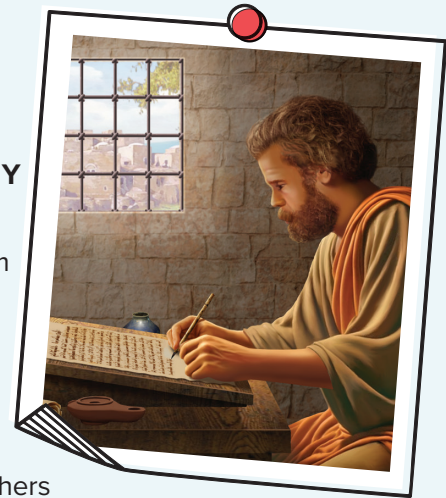
Paul was a missionary who traveled from place to place. He told people about God and Jesus. On one of his trips, Paul met a young man named Timothy. Paul heard people say that Timothy loved God.

Paul asked Timothy to help him tell others about Jesus. Timothy traveled with Paul. They told people about God and Jesus. They helped start new churches so more people could learn what the Bible says.

Later, when Paul and Timothy were not together, Paul wrote Timothy a letter. Paul wrote, "I am praying for you. I remember how much you love God. I know how you want to tell other people about Jesus. I thank God for your mother, Eunice, and your grandmother, Lois, who taught you about God. Since you were a child, you have learned from the Bible. The Bible will help you understand about God and learn about Jesus."

The letter continued, "All that the Bible says is from God. The Bible tells us what God wants us to do, teaches us how to live, and helps us make right choices. Keep doing what the Bible says."

## Paul Spoke to an Angry Crowd

**ACTS 21:15–22:30**

When Paul went to Jerusalem, the Jewish believers welcomed him and listened to Paul. He told about the good things that God was doing among the Gentiles in other places.

The Jewish believers in Jerusalem praised God for all that He was doing. Then they told Paul that some of the Jews were upset. These Jews thought Paul was not teaching the Gentiles to obey God's laws.

These Jews had seen Paul in Asia. They came and stirred up the crowd. "He teaches against our people and our law," they declared, and they tried to kill Paul. The Roman commander sent soldiers to arrest Paul. When the crowd saw the soldiers, they stopped beating him. The mob was so angry and shouted so loudly that the commander could not understand them. He ordered the soldiers to take Paul to the Roman jail to protect him.

Paul could have entered the jail without facing the crowd who tried to kill him, but he wanted to talk to them. With permission, Paul spoke to the people in their own language. Paul said, "I am a Jew, and I wanted to please God, just as you do. I arrested people whom I thought were against God. One day on my way to Damascus to arrest more people, I saw a bright light. I fell to the ground and heard a voice call my name and ask, 'Why are you persecuting Me?'"

"Who are you?" I answered.

"The voice explained He was Jesus, and I was to go into Damascus where someone would tell me what to do. Because I was blind from the light, the men with me led me to Damascus. A believer named Ananias came to me and made me see again. He explained that God planned for me to tell about Jesus to everyone.

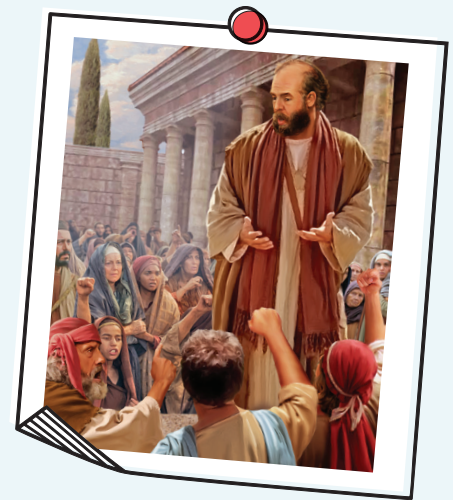
"As soon as I returned to Jerusalem, I went to the temple to pray. I saw Jesus warning me I was in danger. Jesus told me to leave and preach to the Gentiles."

When the men heard this, they shouted for Paul to be killed! The commander ordered him beaten and questioned. But when Paul said he was a Roman citizen, the commander stopped the beating. He took Paul before the Jewish leaders to learn what happened.
