ROCK *Baby Dolls*

Gather two dolls and wrap them in blankets. Give one to your child and keep one for yourself. Demonstrate rocking the baby and encourage him to rock his doll with you. Retell the Bible story (reverse side) as you rock the dolls together. Say: "Hannah was happy to have a baby of her own."

MAKE *a Prayer Jar*

Gather two clean plastic jars with lids and some strips of paper. Brainstorm together names of people you can pray for as a family. Write the names on individual pieces of paper and put them inside one jar. Review the Bible story (reverse side) as your child decorates the filled jar with stickers. Pull a strip of paper from the jar every day at a mealtime and pray for that person. Place the strip into the empty jar.

Babies**LISTEN** *to Worship Music*

Listen to worship songs while on car rides. Review the Bible story (reverse side). Mention that Hannah and her family worshiped God. Tell that they loved God and prayed to Him. Say simple sentence prayers between songs.

Hannah's Family Worshiped God

BASED ON 1 SAMUEL 1; 2:19

Hannah was married to a man named Elkanah (el KAY nuh). They did not have any children. Hannah wanted a baby.

Every year Elkanah and Hannah went to the tabernacle (tent church) in Shiloh. One time, while they were at the tabernacle, Hannah decided to pray about having a baby. She talked to God about how sad she felt. Hannah told God how much she wanted a baby. She said she would teach her baby about God and take him to live at the tabernacle.

God heard Hannah's prayer. Soon Hannah found out that she was going to have a baby! She was very happy!

At last, Hannah's baby was born. She named the baby Samuel. God had answered her prayer!

Samuel grew and grew. Hannah remembered what she had told God in her prayer. She taught Samuel about God. When Samuel was old enough, Hannah took him to the tabernacle to live with a priest named Eli.

Every year Hannah would make Samuel a robe. Hannah and Elkanah would take the robe to Samuel. Hannah thanked God for Samuel.

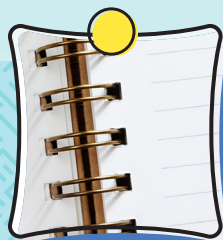


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What Goes TOGETHER?

Hannah's Family Worshiped God

1 SAMUEL 1; 2:19

Hannah was a woman who loved God. She and her husband, Elkanah, had no children, and Hannah desperately wanted a child. Year after year, Elkanah and Hannah traveled from their home in the hill country to Shiloh to worship and offer sacrifices at the tabernacle.

One year when Hannah was at the tabernacle, she prayed and cried to God for a child. She promised that if God would give her a son, she would give the son back to God. She said, “Lord, if You give me a son, I will give him back to You so he can serve You all of his life.”

As she was praying silently, her lips were moving but no sound was coming out. Eli, the priest, saw her and was worried that something was wrong with Hannah. Hannah said to Eli, “I am a woman who is deeply troubled. I have been praying to God out of my sadness.”

Eli said, “Go in peace, and may God grant you what you have asked of Him.”

Hannah and her husband, Elkanah, went home and continued to worship and obey God. After some time Hannah had a son and named him Samuel.

Hannah remembered her promise to God. When Samuel was old enough, Hannah and her family took Samuel to the tabernacle at Shiloh. Hannah made her sacrifice to God and then brought Samuel to the priest, Eli. Hannah said, “I am the woman who stood here beside you praying to the Lord. I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of Him. So now I give him to the Lord. For his whole life he will be given over to the Lord.”

Hannah worshiped God, and then she left Samuel with Eli to serve God. Each year, Hannah made him a robe and took it to him when she went with her husband to offer the sacrifice.
