

Jesus Told About a Kind Man

VERSE

Jesus taught people about God. (Mark 1:14)

BAKE Cookies

Mention that we can be kind to others. Name someone you know who is ill. Allow your child to help you bake cookies for that person. Tell the Bible story (reverse side) as the cookies bake. Pray for that person. Visit your ill friend together and deliver the cookies. Pray together with the friend.

MAKE Care Bags

Gather large ziplock bags and various supplies (prepackaged snacks, small bottles of water, New Testaments, new tube socks, shoelaces, travel toothpaste and toothbrushes). Invite your child to help you assemble the bags for people who are displaced from their homes. Talk about the kind man in the Bible story (reverse side). Remind your child: "Jesus was kind to all. We should be like Jesus and be kind to others." Make a family plan to either distribute the bags or to donate them to a local shelter who helps displaced people.

Jesus told a story about a man who got hurt as he walked along a road.

The first two men who came by did not help him.

The third man helped the hurt man. He put on bandages and took the man to get help.

The third man was kind to the hurt man.

Jesus told a story about a man who traveled down a road. People hurt him and took his money. They left the man lying on the side of the road.

Two men saw the hurt man, but they did not stop to help.

Finally, one man stopped. This man was from the country of Samaria. He was kind and good to the hurt man and helped him.

2s

Jesus told a story about a man who walked on a road to another town. Some people stopped him. They hurt him, tore his clothes, and took his money. They left him lying on the side of the road.

Two different men saw the hurt man but did not stop to help.

A third man saw the hurt man. This man was from the country of Samaria. The man was kind and stopped to help. He bandaged the hurt man and helped the man get on his animal to ride into the town. The kind man paid for the man to be taken care of until he could return. This man showed love and kindness to the hurt man.

Jesus Told About a Kind Man

BASED ON LUKE 10:25-37

A man asked Jesus what rules he should follow to go to heaven. Jesus said, "You should love God and love your neighbor." The man asked, "Who is my neighbor?"

Jesus told a parable (a story that teaches something) to answer him. He said, "A man walked down the road. Robbers hurt him and took his money. They left him by the road."

"A man who worked at the temple came by and saw the hurt man. He crossed the road and walked by without helping. Another man, a church leader, came down the road. He did not help the hurt man either."

"Later, a man from Samaria walked by. He stopped to help. The Samaritan bandaged the hurt man. He placed him on his donkey and took him to an inn. He took care of the hurt man. The next day, the kind man gave the owner of the inn money to take care of the hurt man until he was well again."

After the story, Jesus asked, "Which of the three men treated the hurt man like a neighbor?" The man said, "The one who helped the hurt man." Jesus said, "Go and help others like the kind man did."

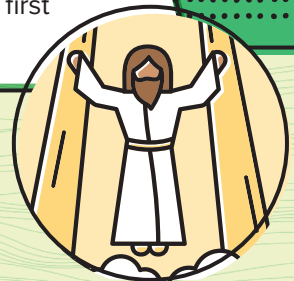

Jesus Taught He Would Return

**MATTHEW 24:29-31,36-44;
JOHN 14:1-3**

Jesus told His disciples that after He went to heaven, He would return for them, and no one would miss the event! He said, "All the people of the earth will see the Son of Man (Jesus' name for Himself) coming in the clouds with power and glory. He will send His angels with the sound of a loud trumpet, and they will gather His people."

Jesus told them, "No one knows the day and hour of My return. Only God the Father knows. So be alert! If a homeowner knew a thief was coming to his house, he would be alert so that his house would not be broken into. In the same way, you must be ready because you know the Son of Man is coming at a time you don't expect."

Jesus did not want His disciples to be worried or anxious about His unexpected return. "Don't let your heart be troubled," He encouraged them. "I am going to prepare a place for you. Then I will come back and bring you to Myself. Where I am, you will be also."
