- **5.** Wrap up by discussing Pastor Nate's closing question: "Are you persistently focused on Jesus?" If you don't like your answer... what's off; persistently, focused, or Jesus? How can we help you choose to make the necessary adjustments?

 (Colossians 2:6-8)
 - a. <u>Legalism</u> a functional belief that through our own effort we can attain salvation and spiritual growth.
 - b. In Colossae this legalism came in the <u>form</u> of Gnosticism, Asceticism, and Mysticism... (<u>Colossians 2:16-21</u>)
 - i. Gnosticism = special knowledge
 - ii. Asceticism = special <u>practice</u>
 - iii. Mysticism = special <u>experience</u>
 - c. These teachings are just as present <u>today</u> as in the 1st Century.
- 2. The <u>tragedy</u> of these distractive and disruptive teachings is that they <u>reimprison</u> free people. (<u>Galatians 5:1</u>)
 - a. Like the lenses in telescopes, binoculars, and microscopes; the order of our <u>spiritual lenses</u> determines how effectively we focus.

- **3.** The only effective order of our focus is to see <u>everything</u> through the lens of Jesus and His life-giving work for us. (Colossians 2:9-10, 13-14)
 - a. This is possible because Jesus has not only provided freedom, but also victory over sin, death and the enemy! (Colossians 2:15)

As we embrace the truth of God's Word we will <u>experience</u> freedom instead of bondage, grace instead of condemnation, and victory instead of defeat.
