- 2. When faced with a huge challenge (such as rebuilding the walls around Jerusalem), it helps to "find your reason to endure." Read <u>Nehemiah 3:1-2</u>, 10, 20 and 28-30. Which of the four reasons resonates with you with what you are facing or have faced in the past leading by example, taking care of your community, preserving everyone's spiritual journey or protecting your household?
- **3.** Read <u>Nehemiah 4:6</u>. What progress do you need to celebrate, or do you need to get out of a cycle of repeating?
- **4.** Pastors Aaron and Tony read through <u>Nehemiah 5:1-13</u>. Take time to re-read this passage and answer these questions: What does it look like for you to fully engage with restitution in your life, and how can you prioritize restoration over reputation?
- **5.** To experience a breakthrough like never before, you must "begin living in a way you've never lived (or that others aren't)." How does that look for you and how will you keep it "a two-way relationship" with God?
