- Icebreaker -

What are three spring projects (of any kind) that you're either excited about, or dreading...and why?

- When you consider how you interact with those around you, how often are those interactions a genuine reflection of God's love? (Read John 3:16, 13:35, 1 Corinthians 13:13, Galatians 5:6b, 5:22a for a refresher on what God's love looks like.)
- **2.** Take just a few minutes to contrast what decisions/actions based on God's love look like compared to those which are reflecting other things.
- **3.** Pastor Tom gave us four key thoughts about God's love...which of these is the most challenging or surprising to you?
  - A. It isn't a human invention, but comes from God's nature, which is love (1 John 4:7-8)
  - **B.** It is visible and a verb (1 John 4:9)
  - C. It compels us to love (2 Corinthians 5:14, 1 John 4:11)
  - **D.** God's love is the reality test, and makes our faith authentic; if we love God, we will love (choose the highest good for) one another (1 John 4:12, 13, 16a)
- **4.** If love is, as Pastor Tom says, "the pre-eminent virtue that makes our faith not a theory but a reality" what does that say about your faith? If you're willing, ask your group to share their perception of how real your faith is.
- **5.** What does choosing the highest good for others to be in the center of God's will look like for you this week? How might this enable you to have a better idea of what to do in your next Now What? moment?

Let's quickly review the first 3 questions we've explored:

#### 1. Will This Choice/Action Be Helpful?

And we unpacked 2 tests the Apostle Paul offers to us to guide our decisions:

- A. Will This Decision/Action Make Me a Better Person?
- B. Does This Decision/Action Control Me, or Do I Control It?

The second important question to ask ourselves is:

2. Does This Decision/Action Bother My Conscience?

The third question to ask ourselves is:

3. Does This Decision/Action Hurt Someone?

The fourth question to ask ourselves is:

Let's quickly review the first 3 questions we've explored:

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**4.** Is This Decision/Action a <u>Genuine</u> Reflection of God's Love?

- It's God's love that brought Jesus on His mission to <u>rescue</u> a lost world (note <u>John 3:16</u>).
- It's His love that identifies us as Jesus' disciples (note John 13:35).
- It's His love that is the supreme <u>virtue</u> on earth and in heaven (note **1 Corinthians 13:13**).
- It's His love that ultimately is the only thing that <u>counts</u> (note **Galatians 5:6b**).
- It's His love that is the <u>fruit</u> of the Spirit (note <u>Galatians 5:22a</u>).

When God's love is genuinely reflected in our lives and relationships, we can have confidence that we are in the right place to receive God's guidance and that we're in the center of His will.

- A. God's love is not a human <u>invention</u> (note <u>1John 4:7b</u>) love comes from God because God's <u>nature</u> is love (note <u>1John 4:8</u>).
- B. God's love is <u>visible</u> it's a <u>verb</u> (action), not a noun (note <u>1John</u> <u>4:9</u>). The cross is the primary <u>source</u> of love. *God's free*, <u>uncaused</u>, and spontaneous (Stott) love becomes that which we respond to in return (note <u>1John</u> <u>4:10</u>).
- C. God's love <u>compels</u> us to love (note <u>2 Corinthians 5:14a</u> and <u>1</u> <u>John 4:11</u>).
- D. God's love is the <u>reality</u> test it's God's love that makes our faith <u>authentic</u> (note <u>1 John 4:12, 13, 16a</u>). The <u>unseen</u> God, who was once revealed in His Son, is now revealed in His people if and when they love one another (Stott). Note <u>1 John 4:16b-17</u> Love is as much a sign of <u>new birth</u> as is righteousness (Stott). To claim to love the unseen God while not choosing for the highest good of others towards the visible images of God is a <u>contradiction</u> that takes away the substance/meaning of the Christian faith (note <u>1 John 4:20</u>). God clearly tells us what <u>success</u> really looks like (note <u>Galatians 5:13-14</u>).

#### So now what?

- God's will for your life and mine is to become fully immersed and <u>participants</u> in His love story (note <u>1John 3:16a</u>).
- When we <u>surrender</u> our lives to the control of the Holy Spirit, God's love story becomes real in our lives (note <u>1 John 3:16b-18</u>).
- Love is the pre-eminent Christian virtue that makes our faith not a <u>theory</u> but a reality.
- Love is the greatest of the 3 <u>eternal</u> graces (faith, hope, and love), and without it all we do or say doesn't matter.
- Every time we choose for the highest good of others (including God Himself), we will be right in the <u>center</u> of His will and much easier guided and directed by Him.
- Have you <u>embraced</u> God's love story for your own life?
- What do our <u>relationships</u>...portray about the reality of God's love in our own lives?
