- 1. As Pastor Tom introduced this new series, he pointed out that many people believe God is a "cosmic scorekeeper." Have you been tempted to think this way, and if so, what were the circumstances or beliefs that led you there?
- 2. Abraham was called to leave all he knew and trust God with his family's future (Genesis 12:1-3). Pastor Tom emphasized "The call to trust is always central to true spirituality." Review the message notes to see the ways God asked Abraham to trust Him. Which of these listed in 1 A-G is hardest for you and why?
- Pastor Tom asked a difficult question when he inquired, "Are we putting conditions on our obedience?" When do you find yourself doing this, and how can you move towards unconditional obedience?
- 4. Pastor Tom reminded us that Abraham was not "extraordinary/ superhuman," but instead understood that "it's about relationship," and "that surrender is the channel through which God's biggest and best blessings flow". (See Galatians 3:6, Romans 4:20-21, Hebrews 11:6 and Romans 12:1.) When have you witnessed or experienced these truths? Explain.
- **5.** Read Mark 8:35. Pastor Tom concluded that God wants "all I am and all I have." What part of surrender challenges you most, and what steps will you take this week to live a more consistently surrendered life?

What are the most important <u>elements</u> of what it means to be truly spiritual and growing in spirituality?
What does God want the most from us?

God = <u>cosmic</u> scorekeeper

Today let's learn from Abraham's spiritual journey what God is really looking for:

I. Abraham's <u>Life</u> Experience Shows What God Wants Most From Us

(Note **Genesis 12:1-3**)

The call to <u>trust</u> is always central to true spirituality.

- A. Famine Will you trust Me to <u>protect</u> you? (note Genesis 12:10-20).
- B. Greed Will you trust Me to provide for you? (note Genesis 13:14-17).
- C. <u>Prosperity</u> Will you trust Me with your possessions? (note Genesis 14:22-23).
- D. <u>Courage</u> Will you trust Me to fulfill My promises? (note **Genesis 15:3, 6, 8**).
- E. Timing Will you trust me by patiently enduring? (note Genesis 16).
- F. Obedience Will you trust Me when what I ask you doesn't make sense? (note Genesis 17).
- G. Final Exam Will you trust Me with everything and <u>everyone</u> in your life? (note Genesis 22:1-4, 10-18). With God, risk really means <u>risk</u> (Lawrence). We'll never know God in His power and love without taking the risk with Him (risk is another term for <u>trust</u>).

So what are we <u>holding</u> on to? Are we putting <u>conditions</u> on our obedience?

Abraham's Confidence in God's <u>Promises</u> is What He's Looking For

Scripture points to Abraham as the *Father of faith* (note **Galatians 3:6**), but not because he was extraordinary/<u>superhuman</u>.

Note Romans 4:20-21

It's not about <u>rules</u>; it's about relationship.

It's not about being a <u>degree</u> nicer and a shade more moral and attending religious activities.

That's the lie of cults and other religions and it's <u>powerless</u> to transform our lives.

What God is looking for is a relationship through Jesus Christ and that relationship happens when we risk <u>surrender</u> (note <u>Hebrews 11:6</u>).

We have to believe God is God and we're not.

And that God rewards those who genuinely seek Him.

Abraham's life tells us that surrender is the <u>channel</u> through which God's biggest and best blessings flow (note <u>Romans 12:1</u> = *give...offer*).

So are you legit?:

- Because what God really wants is you (note Mark 8:35).
- What does God want from me and you?
- He wants all I <u>am</u> and all I <u>have</u>.
