DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Icebreaker -

Is your favorite summer hot & dry... or cool & wet, and why?

- **1.** Pastor Tony led off with some definitions of Legit; which definition resonates with you when you think of them in relation to your walk with Jesus?
- 2. Read Daniel 1:1-3. What were some of the things Daniel was dealing with in his new world that have similarities to yours? How can his example assist you in seeing these things as they really are vs. how someone else wants you to see them?
- **3.** Daniel 1:8 says, "...Daniel resolved not to defile himself...". Pastor Tony defined resolve as "to determine and not be determined". While our culture wants to determine for us how we should be "Christian", how have you resolved to follow Jesus?
- **4.** How does God's support of Daniel make you feel as you read **Daniel 1:9**? How does it affect your resolve as you consider the fact that God is there to support you as He did Daniel?
- **5.** Read Daniel 1:10-21. Daniel and his friends committed to God's plan, not knowing the outcome, and God came through! What are some areas that you need to hand the pen back to the Author and trust Him to write your story?

"Outstanding Resolve"

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What are the most important elements of what it means to be truly <u>spiritual</u> and growing in spirituality?

What does God want the most from us?

Legit: (shortening of legitimate)

- To be in compliance with the law.
- To come across as an <u>impressive</u> example of something.
- To start living <u>right</u> after having previously not.
- To be the <u>real deal</u> even when surrounded by "spin" or "persecution."

This raises the question...are you <u>outstanding</u> in a crowd, or are you out standing in a crowd?

 We'll truly choose to live this kind of life only when we truly understand God's best for us.

Learning from Daniel...

A <u>Distracted</u> Environment (<u>Daniel 1:1-2</u>)

- There were <u>sketchy</u> examples of faith. (v.1a)
- It was a <u>hostile</u> world. (v.1b)
- God's discipline was in effect. (v.2)

Where do you feel this in your life?

A <u>Beguiling</u> Culture (<u>Daniel 1:3-7</u>)

- A mass captivity disguised as a favored "rescue." (v.3)
- A <u>reeducation</u> disguised as a free education. (v.4)
- An indoctrination disguised as a <u>buffet</u>. (v.5)
- An identity <u>theft</u> disguised as a title. (v.6-7)
 - Possibility of emasculation. (v.7)

Where do you feel this in your life?

Intermission...

- What is your <u>inter-mission</u>?
- Are you <u>out standing</u> in a crowd...or are you <u>outstanding</u> in a crowd?
- <u>Compromise</u> doesn't erase tension... it only weakens our <u>resolve</u>.

An Outstanding Resolve (Daniel 1:8)

- To resolve is to <u>determine</u> and not be <u>determined</u>...to consider the larger <u>Truth</u> over the loudest <u>shouting</u>. (v.7a)
- You can avoid being <u>defiled</u> with <u>respect</u>. (v.7b)

A Divine Ally (Daniel 1:9)

• "Now God...": God has an <u>infinite</u> amount of support to hand us if we'd only give Him a running start. (v.9)

A Powerful Redirection (Daniel 1:10-21)

• Daniel made up his mind before he knew how the story ended... because he handed the <u>pen</u> to the <u>Author</u>.

So are you legit?:

- Have you said 'YES!' to Jesus Christ?
- In what ways do (and don't) your habits help you <u>understand</u> and appreciate that relationship (and God's best)?
- When you let God speak His best into you, saying "No" to the world is a complete sentence.

Don't miss this...
