DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Icebreaker -Name a food/meal that you never liked as a kid but have since changed your mind. What caused the change?*

- 1. Our families of origin have a huge impact on "how we got here". Read Genesis 37:1-5. Young Joseph seems clueless as to how exposing his brothers and bragging to them about his dreams might be received, while his brothers were quick to take offense and go on the offensive. How do you act in love in volatile situations like these and what impact do such actions have on them?
- 2. Pastor Tony reviewed how God both moved Joseph (Genesis 37:6-11) and allowed him to experience great difficulty (Genesis 37:19-20, 28; 39:11-23; 40:23, 41:1-13). What do you see in Joseph's response that might help you respond well when you experience unforeseen challenges?
- **3.** "Whether today is amazing or devastating, God is with us and can help us grow into what 'being there' means." Pastor Tony challenged us to be like Joseph in how he responded to adversity. Review the list of verses and bullets under "Being there..." in the Message Notes. Which of these challenges you most and what steps will you take to ask for God's help in this area?
- **4.** Pastor Tony reminded us that God *can* "connect dots that you only see as periods." Why is it important to praise God in our difficult circumstances and how can you see the next "period" as a "connecting dot" in your life?
- **5.** Read the "Don't miss this..." section of the Message Notes. Joseph didn't wait to serve until he was in a more comfortable position, but faithfully served even when his circumstances were "less," even as a slave and a prisoner! What circumstances in your life are hindering you from serving? Could it be that God is asking you to serve despite those circumstances, and if so, what steps will you take this week to make that happen?
