# **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

- Icebreaker -

Imagine only being able to see black, white, and one other color. If you could choose, what would that color be and why?

- Pastor Tom made clear that Jesus "didn't treat truth as a personal preference, but declared that truth exists as an objective reality." (John 8:31-32) How does this contradict the attitude of our culture and why does it make sharing Jesus with others so difficult?
- **2.** Pastor Tom declared that, "God doesn't play hide and go seek with people," but rather wants people to know both Him and the truth. (See **Matthew 7:7-8**). Aside from the Scriptures, what are some other ways that God reveals Himself and demonstrates His love to humanity?
- 3. "Jesus", Pastor Tom explained, "didn't define truth as a concept, or an idea, or even a principle, but as a Person. Himself."
  (John 14:1-6) How can you use your experience of Jesus as "the truth" to help lead others to Christ?
- **4.** Pastor Tom noted that Pontius Pilot refused to see the truth, even when he was literally "staring into (its) face...because of pride, politics, and pandering." How/When have you seen these things blind or distract yourself and others from the truth as seen in Jesus?
- **5.** In the introduction to his book, *Is God Real?*, Lee Strobel recounts the individual stories of nine people (pages 7-9) who were adamantly opposed to the truth of Christianity but, upon investigation, ultimately said "YES!" to Jesus. What are some of the reasons they gave for embracing Jesus as truth, and what do they tell you about the needs of people in your life that only Jesus can fill?

Our common search as human beings revolves around some <u>pressing</u> life questions:

- Can truth be known?
- Does God exist?
- Can the Bible be trusted?
- Why is there evil and suffering?

#### Note **John 14:1-6**

As Jesus often did, He made a clear, straightforward statement that day 2,000 years ago that spoke <u>volumes</u> to people then and it still does today, too.

Jesus is telling us 3 powerfully relevant things:

## 1. I Can Know that Truth Exists

It's also popular (and totally <u>illogical</u>) for some to claim that there's no such thing as right or wrong/truth or error...

Jesus doesn't permit such illogical, <u>faulty</u> reasoning about either Himself or truth.

He didn't treat truth as a personal preference, but declared that truth exists as an <u>objective</u> reality.

### 2. I Can <u>Know</u> the Truth

One of the greatest <u>untruths</u> repeatedly told in our 21<sup>st</sup> century world is that truth cannot be known.

This kind of reasoning is hopelessly contradictory...

Most people have never considered the scientific, philosophical, historical, and experiential <u>evidence</u> for Jesus who declared He is the truth.

God doesn't play <u>hide</u> and go <u>seek</u> with people. He wants us to <u>know</u> Him (note **Matthew 7:7-8**). Jesus plainly stated that truth can be known (note **John 8:31-32**).

He said if we become His fully-devoted followers that we will KNOW the truth, and knowing truth will be the ultimate <u>liberating</u> experience of our lives.

### 3. I Can Live in Relationship with the Truth

Jesus didn't define truth as a concept, or an <u>idea</u>, or even a principle, but as a Person. <u>Himself</u>.

Pontius Pilate...

...he was staring into the face of <u>absolute</u> truth but refused to see it (because of <u>pride</u>, politics, and pandering).

He refused to let Jesus shake up and transform his life, and his eternal legacy is one of having truth in his hands but <u>rejecting</u> it with his mind and heart.

#### So is God real?:

• If you're here today and you're intellectually <u>honest</u> and a sincere seeker after God, I invite you to reach out, embrace Jesus, take Him at His Word, and find Him to be the real reason for living.

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
