Problem today is that many people confuse truth with <u>perspective</u>. But *your truth* can actually be a <u>trap</u> (note **Proverbs 14:12**).

2. Just Because I <u>Believe</u> Something Doesn't Make it True

Your <u>story</u> matters.

But what I experience and you experience doesn't equate with <u>absolute</u> truth.

Follow your <u>heart</u>... (problem = Jeremiah 17:9).

If I let my feelings determine my truth, I'm in trouble, because my feelings <u>lie</u>.

Note 2 Timothy 4:2-5a

God's Word never <u>changes</u> (note **Psalm 119:89**; **Isaiah 40:8**; **Matthew 24:35**).

3. Truth Isn't a Thing; Truth is a <u>Person</u>
