What's the alternative to boasting, roasting and ghosting?

The Instruction: Reclaim Normal through honor. (Romans 12:9-16)

- Not quick flattery, but guided goodness. (v.9)
- Not a trade-off, but committed <u>out-doing</u>. (v.10)
- Not reluctant, but <u>passionate</u>. (v.11)
- Not comfortable, but <u>inconvenienced</u>. (v.12)
- Not selective, but <u>unfiltered</u>. (v.13)
- Not reactive, but gracious. (v.14)
- Not unresponsive, but empathetic. (v. 15)
- Not competitive, but <u>humble</u>. (v.16)
