DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Icebreaker -

If your small group had a group mascot, what would it be and why?

- **1.** Answer Pastor Tom's initial question, "Why is it hard to serve one another?" Be as specific as possible.
- 2. Read Mark 10:45 and Galatians 5:13. Pastor Tom stated that, "We're only genuinely free when we live the life God created us to live." Describe how serving others frees us to "be and do what Jesus wants."
- **3.** Pastor Tom explained that serving helps fulfill the intention of the Old Testament law (see **Galatians 5:14** and **Matthew 7:12**). How does knowing this make serving others easier for you, or does it?
- 4. Read Galatians 5:16-26. Pastor Tom explained that "legalism and libertarianism are not answers" to the serving dilemma; rather, being filled with the Holy Spirit as outlined in Ephesians 5:18 is the answer. What steps will you take this week to be continually filled and controlled by the Holy Spirit?
- **5.** "The best way to find yourself is to lose yourself in the service of others." (Engstrom) How might trying a First Serve or how has serving regularly helped you discover more about yourself?

How can this be the case?

How can the most <u>connected</u> culture in history be struggling to find meaningful relationships?

In the New Testament alone, there are at least 41 <u>distinct</u> passages on how we're to relate and deal with each other often referred to as the *one* anothers.

First reality we have to grapple with is:

$oldsymbol{\mathsf{L}}$ Why Is It $oldsymbol{\mathsf{Hard}}$ to Serve One Another?

As Jesus followers we know we're to serve <u>God</u>... ...But serving each other can be more <u>challenging</u> at times. Serve = aid, assist, benefit, help, supply, <u>support</u>, uphold.

Note **Galatians 5:15**Fighting tooth and nail...

2. We Experience True Freedom

Christian freedom isn't a license to practice <u>evil</u> (note **Galatians 5:13a, b**). Christian freedom is to <u>be</u> and do what Jesus wants.

What have we been freed for?

Slavery! (note Galatians 5:13c)

Serve = permanent surrender of personal rights in attitude of \underline{total} surrender.

Note Mark 10:45

We're only genuinely free when we live the life that God <u>created</u> us to live.

4. So How Do We Do This?

Legalism and libertarianism are not answers...

Note Galatians 5:16

...live, walk, be led, be controlled, be <u>filled</u>, keep in step with the Spirit...

Note Galatians 5:17, 20-21a

Apart from the working of the Holy Spirit in our lives, serving others is at best a <u>chore</u>/obligation if it's even on our radar screen.

Note Galatians 5:22-23

We're commanded to be <u>filled</u> with the Holy Spirit (note **Ephesians 5:18**). The Spirit-filled life is a life of <u>healthy</u> relationships... (note **Galatians 5:25-26**).

SO MY NEXT STEP IN PEOPLE-ING 101:

- Actually, the challenge to *serve* one another is an <u>invitation</u> to be filled and controlled by the Holy Spirit.
- Fulfillment, meaning, genuine purpose, and freedom is found as we embrace this profound spiritual <u>reality</u> of serving Jesus and others.
