## DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Icebreaker -

*Imagine instead of a signature you had to sign documents with a picture of something or someplace. Assuming you could choose anything/anywhere, what pic would you pick for your "signature" and why?*

1. Pastor Tom said that leadership is always a privilege because it means that God has given you a place of influence in someone else's life. Who are some people you have the privilege to influence and how do you do intentionally use that influence to lead them?
2. Read **Exodus 33:7-10**. Leadership isn't always about what people hear from us but is also about what they see. What do your actions/ behaviors say to people about who you are as a leader and where you want to lead them?
3. Read **Exodus 33:11-17**. Whether leading a home or a business, knowing that you don't know it all is essential for any godly leader. As a leader, how does/should this awareness impact your interactions with God and with those you lead?
4. The leadership model given by Jesus in **Matthew 20:25-28** is described by Pastor Tom as, "...not ego-driven, self-sufficient, bossy-type, but a dedicated servant with humility and genuine dependence on the Lord." What does it look like for you to be 'genuinely dependent' on God in your leadership; how does your dependence reveal itself?
5. Pastor Tom said that godly leadership is "always about God" and continually reflects His "loving and gracious presence" and character in the way we lead. Without it, all our best leadership gifts and skills are meaningless. How has your leadership influence been infused with God's love and grace? If it hasn't, what will you do to correct it?
