- Icebreaker -

What is one thing that you think everyone should experience in life, and why?

1. Think about a milestone moment in your life when God was clearly at work—either in the moment or in a way you recognized later in hindsight. Did that moment break something, bless something, or restore something in your life? How?
2. In **Exodus 24:3**, the people say, “Everything the Lord has said we will do,” but by **Exodus 32:8** they have already turned away. What does this reveal about human nature and our relationship with God?
3. It’s easy to shake our heads at the Israelites, yet we often rebel against God in our own ways as well. When that has happened in your life, how has God gotten your attention and led you into humble restoration with Him?
4. It’s possible to follow God outwardly without being truly close to Him. Moses, however, was known for “being with God” and it showed. Think of someone you know who seems to live that way. What sets them apart, and how did they become like that? What is one thing you see in their life that you would want to imitate in your own walk with God?
5. What is one practical way you could grow in loving God or loving others this week?
