DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Icebreaker -

What is one thing that you really enjoy doing that is a chore or a bore for most people and what do you find so enjoyable about it?

- 1.** Pastor Tom stated that everyone holds a position of leadership somewhere in their lives, so all of us know the headaches that can come with leadership. Name at least one of your leadership roles and what kinds of headaches you have/are experiencing.
- 2.** Read **Numbers 12:1-2**. Moses' own brother and sister were undermining him. Have you ever faced feeling betrayed in leadership by someone you totally trusted and how did you respond?
- 3.** Review Numbers, chapters 11 and 12. When Moses faced headaches in **Numbers 11:10-15**, his response was to blow a gasket. But in **Numbers 12:1-5**, in response to a new and more personal headache, Moses "stayed quiet" and entrusted it to God. What has happened that changed Moses' approach, and what can you learn from his experience?
- 4.** Read **Numbers 14:3-5, 11-19**. What unexpected roles does Moses take on in these two passages, and how will you incorporate these same roles into the leadership positions you fill?
- 5.** Moses had become a great leader. In **Numbers 14:12**, God once again suggests that due to the people's sin He would wipe them out and start over making a great nation out of Moses and his descendants. How hard would it be for you to push back TWICE on God's invitation to honor you? What kept Moses in check (See **Numbers 12:3**)?
