- Icebreaker -

1. Dr. Stumbo reviewed the many dramatic transitions of Joseph's life from "favored son to slave, favored slave to prisoner, favored prisoner to forgotten prisoner, and forgotten prisoner to ruler of Egypt." What have been the most dramatic transitions in your life, and how did you feel about them?
2. Dr. Stumbo quipped that change is "fertile soil" for fear that can lead us to "make poor decisions and reach bad conclusions." How has fear, brought on by unexpected or unwelcome change, affected your decision-making, your perspective, or your faith?
3. Change doesn't have to lead to fear, it can also lead to a deeper, "four-wheel drive" sort of faith. Tell of a time when you have had to "four-wheel it" in your faith. What was it like and how did it turn out?
4. Dr. Stumbo shared how a health crisis stripped him of his strength, voice, mobility, and ministry, leaving him "one confused guy for a while" - until he landed on the truth, "God is in this and God is good." How would clinging to that truth help you endure a storm?
5. From sinner to saint, estranged to friend of God, lost to found, living for self to living for Him, bondage to freedom, despair to hope: Which of these "from/to Gospel" statements do you resonate most with and why?
