DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Icebreaker -

Think back to your experiences with group projects in school (like Pastor Kyle did last Sunday). Since you can no longer get a bad grade for fessing up, what role did you most often play in the group: the smart kid, the talker, the "too cool to do this" guy, the flirt, the disinterested one, or something else?

1. Pastor Kyle declared that "we were created for Mission", to "be a part of something bigger than ourselves." What are some of the missions that have motivated your life?
2. Pastor Kyle said that God's heart is not "to give you your best life now", but rather to give you a whole NEW life that "reorients our heart back around God" (see **2 Corinthians 5:17-18**). How is the focus of the first idea different from the second and how might that difference play out in our understanding of our life mission?
3. Read **2 Corinthians 5:18b-20**. This scripture indicates that "You are God's plan...you are not His second choice." How can God have that much confidence in us; and what has He given us to fill Him with such assurance? Do you take courage from His confidence?
4. Have you ever been a part of a church that, in the face of our morally corrupt and increasingly hostile culture, developed what Pastor Kyle called a "defeatist mentality" and chose to just "circle the wagons" and try to survive until Jesus comes? What does that kind of church/Christian look like and why do so many find it alluring? What's the antidote?
5. Pastor Kyle introduced us to a new phrase that he is going to be using throughout this series: **Mission Means Me**. How do you respond to that call and how do you see it applying to your life?
