- Icebreaker -

What television family is the

1. Do you regularly feel the empowerment of the Holy Spirit inside you and how does it give you confidence to live as Jesus commands?
2. Read **Romans 8:11** and **Philippians 3:10a**. If we believe what the Bible says is true—that we will be raised just as Christ was—how does the power of the resurrection enable you to endure discomfort, insult, accusation, slander, belittling, etc. for the mission of Jesus?
3. Pastor Kyle shared a story about a young man trapped in a sin spiral of pornography. While a Christ-follower who recognized that it was destructive, He had yet to discover that he had to fight with the resurrection power of God to overcome it. The young man's fight started with his surrender to Christ, moved into confession and then into action. Think of your "sin spiral": what is the next swing in the fight that you need to take as you lean into the resurrection power available to you?
4. Read **Ephesians 3:16-19**. Take 5 minutes to write down in your own words, a description of God's love for you based on those verses.

CHALLENGE: Read the verses and your description at least twice every day this week. Report back to your small group during your next meeting about how this has impacted your life.

5. *Because of grace: I have the power to never die; I have power over sin; I have the power to know God's love; and I have the power to be a witness. If you lived your whole life on these promises, how would that change your life?*
