DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Icebreaker -

What is something you want people to notice about you when they come to your house, something you don't want them to notice?

1. Read **Daniel 1:3-21**. We experience the consequences of evil in 3 primary ways: 1) by our own sin; 2) by the sinful actions of others that impact us and; 3) by the "spiritual forces of evil" who war against humanity described in Ephesians 6:12. Considering these three sources, what perspective might Daniel be working from that makes it possible for him to treat his captor (whose sinful actions are impacting Daniel) with such respect and consideration rather than just going on a hunger strike to avoid being defiled by the King's food? How does seeing others who sin against you as being victims of the "spiritual forces of evil" impact the way you see and treat them?
2. In what ways did the Babylonians seek to change the identity of Daniel and his friends and why do you think they did this? Why is who Jesus says you are so important to your walk with Him?
3. Pastor Kyle said, "It's so easy for our happiness to be dependent, not on evil things but on great things we've made into ultimate things... And that's how you know re-education is effective. They change your identity. Change your truth. Change your dependence." Where have you felt this pressure to change who you are most strongly and how have you pushed back?
4. In **Daniel 1:8**, what was Daniel's reasoning for not eating the king's food and drink? What good things has Satan used to try to defile you? (See **1 John 2:15-17**)
5. What can we do to remind ourselves of our true identities - of where we really belong and who we really belong to?
6. Though you live in exile, what advantages do you have as a Christ follower - even in the midst of the pressure you experience from not going along with the world?
