We are so excited and looking forward to the launching of our 3rd physical campus in Buffalo with our Grand Opening Sunday, August 4, 2024! God has provided for us a facility we are completely remodeling, which will look different from both our Big Lake and Sauk Rapids campuses, and its location is at one of the busiest intersections in Wright County, I believe. The possibilities of reaching so many lost



people through this campus are great, and we thank our great God for working and continuing to work in so many ways for His glory through this huge project.

We praise the Lord for the faithful giving of Riversiders over the past decade which meant we were able to purchase this property with cash, and God willing, we will be able to complete the remodel of this building with cash! That's no small thing any time, but especially when economic times are uncertain.

Our challenge now as a church is to give generously and sacrificially to ensure we are able to fully fund the operations/ministries of all 3 campuses in future years, and to rebuild our cash reserves so we are ready when God opens the next door for us to pursue. Be open to what God is saying to you about your NEXT **STEPS** of generosity.

We are delighted to share how God has been faithful in accomplishing Riverside Church's mission to reach people with the Good News of Jesus and help them become His fully devoted followers over the past year.

We have welcomed new faces almost every week. Our Riverside Kids and Riverside Students ministries continue to flourish, and we are thrilled to share that 151 people followed God's call and were baptized. Additionally, we received 85 new members into our fellowship, and our small groups saw regular participation of 1,365 individuals. Most amazingly, 941 people repented and said 'YES!' to Jesus as their Lord this year, surpassing last year's numbers—praise God for His incredible work!

Last year, we shared how God opened the door for us to purchase the Buffalo Campus facility. After extensive renovations, we are excited to announce that we are ready to launch this new campus later this summer. Thanks to your generous contributions and our careful financial management, we are able to do this without incurring any debt. We serve a good, powerful, and faithful God!

All glory goes to God for these achievements, but it is also remarkable that He chooses to involve His followers in His work. If you are in Jesus, your prayers for those around you matter.
