

MEXICO SHORT TERM TEAMS HANDBOOK





BOB & CHERYL FUGATE: Site Leaders

Bob and Cheryl Fugate are heading up the team in Guadalajara, Mexico, which includes multiple international workers as well as local leadership. Following pastoral ministry in State College, PA, the Fugates served with the Christian and Missionary Alliance for 24 years in Santiago, Chile, before accepting a call in 2014 to redeploy to Guadalajara, Mexico. They have been engaged in church planting since July 2014 and in April 2015 launched a new church, Breath of Life (Aliento de Vida).





The Work in Guadalajara: 5/5/25

The vision for this church has expanded to become a multiplying ministry that seeks to plant 5 campus churches in Guadalajara and send 5 church planting core teams to surrounding states by the year 2025. This project is named Project Southpointe and the strategic vision that is being implemented, 5/5/25. Currently, the church has 4 campuses in Guadalajara and there are church planting teams working in two outlying states.



FAQs: Traveling to Guadalajara, Mexico

Guadalajara is a popular inland city, Mexico's second largest, and capital of the western state of Jalisco. Sports, culture and commerce come together in this thriving, cosmopolitan city with an historic center.

Is there a Visa requirement?

No; however, a valid U.S. passport is required for travelers visiting from the United States which must be valid 6 months after your return to the United States.

Are any vaccinations required?

None.

What is the local time zone?

Central Time Zone (don't observe DST)

What currency is accepted?

Mexican Peso (MXN). Major U.S. credit cards are accepted at hotels, large stores, and restaurants. It is recommended to carry pesos (which you can exchange at the airport) for local shops.


Can I get by without speaking Spanish?

Spanish is the primary written and spoken language throughout the state. Major attractions, hotels and restaurants will have information in English with some staff speaking English. Outside of the city-center English becomes more limited. The team in Guadalajara will also be accompanying Riverside teams throughout trips and will assist in translation. Learning some basic Spanish is helpful, even if not required. (Use DuoLingo, Babbel apps, etc. – see also Spanish phrasebook below)

What do I wear?

Street Dress. In the city, the latest styles are more accepted than in the country. In the country the culture is still very modest. Men wear pants instead of shorts unless at the beach or an outdoor activity. Women should dress modestly, can wear capri pants or lightweight pants with short-sleeved shirts or t-shirts. Spaghetti-strap shirts should be avoided.

Church Dress. Men can wear dress pants, khakis or jeans with a dress shirt to church. Women can wear a knee-length or longer skirt, or nice dress slacks and dress top. It is dress/casual at most of the Alliance churches.


