

BUILD a Church

Help your child build a church with interlocking blocks. Remark that Hannah and her husband went to worship God. Tell that Hannah prayed and asked God for a son. Mention that your family goes to church. Name some of the things your child does at church (pray, sing, learn about Jesus, etc.). Say: "Families can love and worship God."

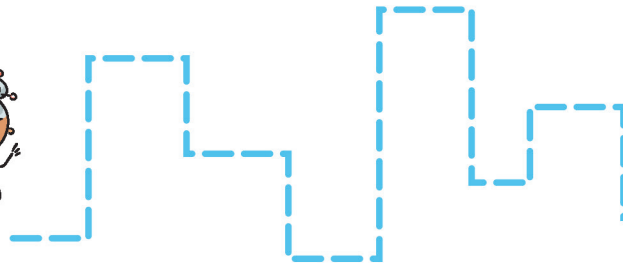
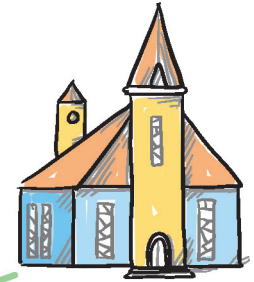
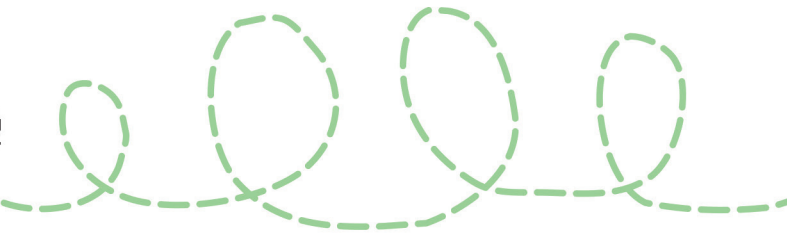

Hannah and her husband, Elkanah, did not have any children. They went to the tabernacle (tent church) once a year to worship God. Hannah prayed and cried as she asked God for a son. She promised that if God gave her a son she would give her son to God all of his life.

The church helper, Eli, saw Hannah praying and asked why she was crying. She told Eli she was praying to God. Eli responded, "May God give you what you prayed for."

Hannah and Elkanah worshiped God at the tabernacle; then they went home.

Later Hannah gave birth to a son. She named him Samuel. When Samuel was older, she took him to the tabernacle. She took him to Eli and said, "Here is the son I prayed for, and I am giving him back to God."

Hannah told Eli that she wanted Samuel to serve God for all of his life. Eli worshiped God when he heard Hannah's words.

Hannah's Family Worshiped God

1 SAMUEL 1

Hannah and her husband Elkanah traveled to the tabernacle in Shiloh to worship God. Hannah was sad because she and her husband did not have any children: so sad she could not eat and was crying.

Hannah went to the tabernacle to pray. She told God that if she had a son, she would make sure he served God.

Eli, the priest, saw Hannah. Her lips were moving but she was not speaking. Eli did not understand what she was doing. Hannah said, "I'm praying. I am so sad."

Eli said, "May God give you what you prayed for."

Hannah felt better. She went to eat some food. She and Elkanah worshiped God. They traveled home.

God had heard Hannah's prayer. Soon she had a baby boy and named him Samuel. She cared for Samuel and remembered her promise to God. When Samuel was still young, she took him to the tabernacle. She told Eli that Samuel would stay with him at the tabernacle.

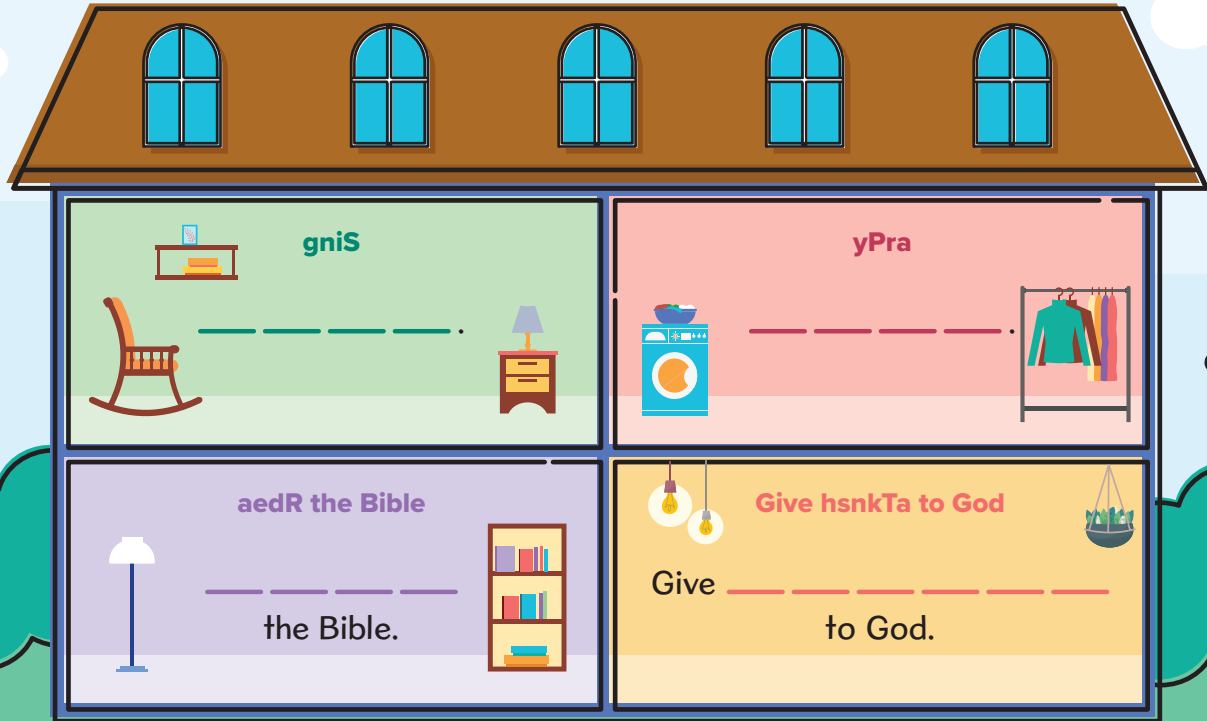

Hannah's Family Worshiped God

1 SAMUEL 1

Hannah was heartbroken. She had no children of her own. She was married to Elkanah and she wanted to have a baby very much.

Every year Elkanah took his family to worship God and offer sacrifices at the tabernacle in Shiloh. While there, Hannah would be

sad and cry so deeply she would not eat. Hannah prayed to God at the tabernacle as she cried. She told God how sad she was. She asked God to give her a son. She promised she would dedicate the child to God so that he would serve God all of his life.

There was a priest at the tabernacle named Eli. He saw Hannah moving her lips as she prayed silently, but he could not understand what she was doing. Hannah explained that she was praying to God. Eli now understood. He believed that God heard Hannah's prayer and told Hannah to go in peace and that he thought God would grant her request.

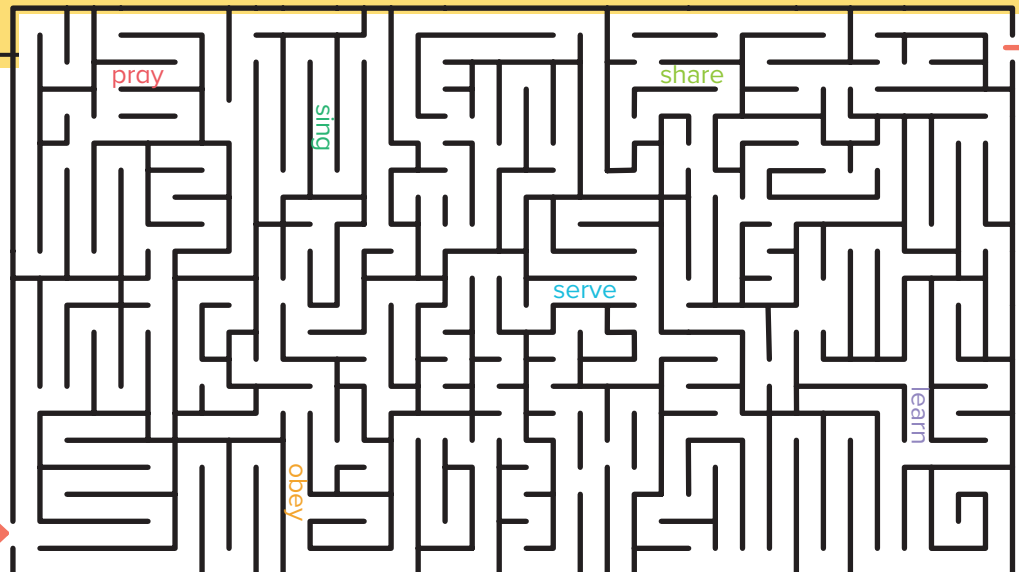

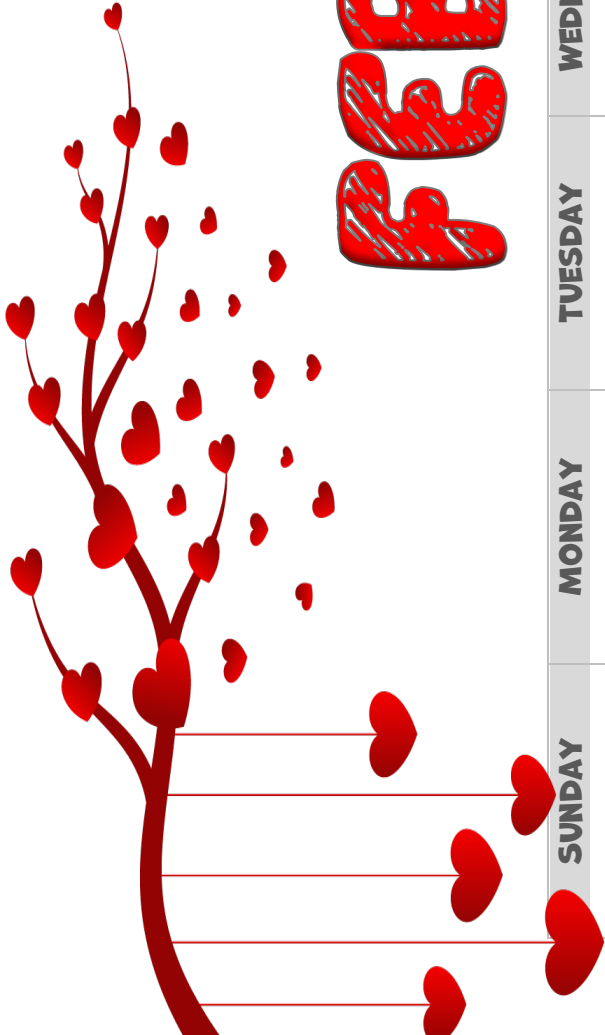

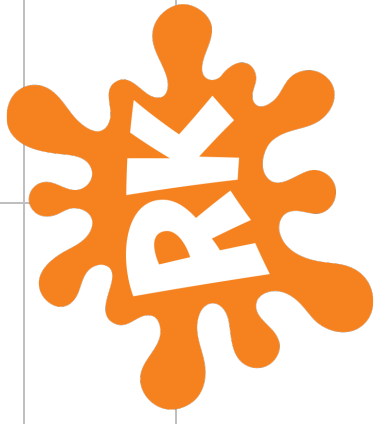
