LIVE IT OUT



Zechariah asked, "How can this be? My wife and I are old."


The angel said, "Because you do not believe me, you will not be able to talk until after baby John is born." Zechariah could only make motions with his hands to explain what had happened.







LUKE 1:5-25.39-45.57-66

When Zechariah came out of the temple he could not speak. He made signs with his hands. The people knew Zechariah had seen a vision.






