VERSE

"God made everything." NEHEMIAH 9:6

EXPLORE God's Creation

Go for a walk outside. Point out some of the wonderful things that God created—grass, trees, flowers, birds, and clouds. Encourage your child to use her senses of sight, hearing, smell, and touch to explore different aspects of nature. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Say a simple prayer, thanking God for His amazing creation.

MOLD DOUGH

Show your child how to use the dough to mold shapes and objects. Explain that we can use the dough and other materials to "make" things, but only God can truly create something from nothing at all. Tell the Bible story (reverse side) as you mold. State: "God made the earth and everything on it. Nehemiah 9:6."


Recipe: Combine 2 cups plain flour and 1 cup salt. Add 1 tablespoon oil, 2 drops liquid food color, and ½ to 1 cup cold water. Mix until combined. Place in a sealed container.



Go on a NATURE WALK

Talk about what you see. Point out things in nature. Tell the Bible story (reverse side). Help your child touch a flower or plants. Thank God for making the earth and everything on it.




God created the world. He created the light, called *day*, and dark, called *night*.


Next God made the sky and separated the land and waters. He called the waters *seas* and the land *earth*.

WEEKLY VERSE: God made the earth and everything on it. *Nehemiah 9:6*

LIFE POINT: God made all the world.



In the beginning, God created the world. The world was dark and empty. Water covered the earth, and there was no light.

God said, "Let there be light!" Suddenly, the light began to shine. Now there was both light and darkness. God called the light *day* and the darkness *night*. This was the first day.


On the second day, God separated the water. He created a huge space above the earth. He called the space *sky*.

On day three, God made dry land. He gathered water into oceans, rivers, and lakes. God made plants and trees to grow on the earth. GENESIS 1:1-13

Before there was earth; before there was a sun; before there was anything at all ... there was God. God has always been. It was God who created the heavens and the earth and everything else.

In the beginning, the earth was formless and empty. Darkness and water covered everything.

Then one day, God spoke and



created light and separated the light from the darkness. God called the light "day" and the darkness "night." That was the first day.


On the second day, God spoke and created the sky and placed it above the water.



GENESIS 1:1-2:3

Before there was anything, there was only God. In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. On the first day God spoke, "Let there be light." And there was light. God saw the light was good. It separated the darkness. God made the day and night on the first day.



On the second day, God spoke

again. He created a vast open space to separate waters. He called the huge expanse "sky."

On the third day, God said, "Let the waters be gathered and dry land appear." And it happened. God saw it was good. He called the dry land "earth" and the waters "seas." God said, "Let the trees and plants grow from the earth." God made every kind of seed-bearing plant and fruitbearing tree. God saw that it was good.

On the fourth day, God spoke and created the sun, moon, and stars. He placed the sun to shine bright in the day and the moon and stars to shine at night. They would be signs for the changing of seasons, days, and years. God saw it was good.

On the fifth day, God spoke again. He made every kind of fish and sea mammal to fill the waters. He made every kind of bird to fly in the sky. God saw that it was good.


On the sixth day, when God spoke, He made every kind of animal to roam on the earth. God planned for the animals to have babies so there would be more animals. God saw it was good.






