

Observe **NEW LIFE**

Say that in springtime, there are signs of new life all around us. Point out signs of spring (flowers, green grass, butterflies, baby ducklings, etc.) in your yard or neighborhood. Tell the Bible story. Say that we celebrate that Jesus is alive.





PAINT a CROSS

Use masking or painter's tape to make a cross on a sheet of paper, an index card, or a piece of cardboard. Invite your child to use crayons or watercolor paint to color on and around the cross. Peel the tape away to reveal a cross shape surrounded by color. Write Jesus is alive. Matthew 28:7 on the picture Display the cross in a visible place in your home. Review the Bible story (reverse side) during the week.







The women were happy. They ran to find the disciples so they could tell them the good news.


Suddenly, the two women saw Jesus! They ran to Jesus and worshiped Him.





Jesus Is Alive!

MATTHEW 28:1-10

We know that Jesus lived on earth, He taught people, healed people, and did the things God wanted Him to do. Then Jesus died on the cross to save people from their sins.

Three days later, on Sunday morning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb where Jesus was buried.




An angel of God came down from heaven, he rolled the stone away from the entrance to the tomb and sat on the stone. The angel was shining, and his clothes were as white as snow. The guards at the tomb were so afraid they fainted.


When the women arrived at the tomb, the angel told them not to be afraid. The angel said Jesus had risen, just as He had said He would. The angel told the women to see the empty tomb and then to quickly go and tell the disciples. The angel said Jesus would see the disciples in Galilee.

CONVERSATION

Jesus Died for Sinners

MATTHEW 26:36-28:10

Jesus went to the garden to pray with some of His disciples. Judas, one of His disciples, arrived with a crowd. Men in the crowd arrested Jesus and led Him away to Caiaphas, the high priest. At Caiaphas' house many people brought false charges against Jesus. After listening to the false charges, Caiaphas asked the people, "What do you think?" The crowd answered that Jesus should be put to death. Then they mocked and beat Jesus. Peter, one of Jesus'



disciples, saw what was happening. A girl asked Peter if he knew Jesus. Then two more people asked Peter if he knew Jesus. Each time Peter answered, "I do not know the man."

Then Peter realized he had lied, and he was very sorry. The next morning the religious leaders tied Jesus up and brought Him to Pilate, the governor. Pilate asked, "What has Jesus done wrong?"

No one answered. The crowd shouted, "Crucify Him!" Pilate let the people crucify Jesus. That afternoon darkness came over the land. Jesus called out to God, then Jesus died on the cross. Suddenly the curtain in the temple was torn from top to bottom, and the earth shook. When the guards saw what happened, they said, "Truly this was the Son of God!" Then Joseph of Arimathea, a follower of Jesus, asked Pilate, "May I bury Jesus' body?"

Joseph took the body, wrapped it in fine linen, placed it in his tomb, and rolled a large stone against the entrance. Three days later, some women went to visit Jesus' tomb. When the women arrived, the stone was rolled away from the entrance. An angel was sitting on the stone and told the women, "Don't be afraid. Jesus is not here. He is risen!"

The women ran to tell the disciples the good news! On the way, Jesus appeared to them. They took hold of His feet and worshiped Him. Jesus had been raised from the dead and was alive!

Through the Bible story kids learned that Jesus took the punishment for sin by giving up His life. Jesus obeyed God's plan for salvation by willingly dying for sinful people.







Jesus Died for Sinners

MATTHEW 26:36-28:10

Jesus took His disciples to the garden of Gethsemane. He knew that He was about to die. Three times Jesus prayed, "Father, please let this pass from Me. Not My will but Your will be done."

Suddenly, Judas arrived with a large crowd carrying swords and clubs. Judas kissed Jesus so the crowd would know who Jesus was. The men grabbed Jesus and arrested Him.

Jesus was taken to Caiaphas, the high priest. He accused Jesus of claiming to be God, a crime deserving death. The leaders mocked Jesus, and witnesses told false stories about Him.

Peter, one of Jesus' disciples, waited outside. "You were with Jesus,"

shouted, "Crucify Him!" Pilate agreed to put Jesus to death.

some people said. Three times Peter said that he did not know Jesus.

The leaders took Jesus to Pilate, the governor. Pilate could not find that
Jesus had done anything wrong. He tried to set Jesus free, but the crowds

Soldiers beat Jesus, put a robe on Him, and placed a crown of sharp thorns on His head. They led Jesus to a place called Golgotha and nailed Him to a cross. From noon until three in the afternoon, darkness covered the land. Jesus cried out, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken (turned away from) Me?" Soon after, He shouted again with a loud voice, and then He died.

One of the guards said, "This man really was the Son of God!"

That evening friends placed Jesus' body in a tomb and rolled a large stone against the entrance. The next day the church leaders sealed the entrance and posted guards to stop anyone from taking Jesus' body. But on the third day, guards could not stop the earthquake that shook the ground or the angel who rolled back the stone. The guards were so afraid that they dropped to the ground as if they were dead!

Some women had come to the tomb to care for Jesus' body. The angel said, "He is not here! He is risen, just as He said! Come and see!"

As the women ran to tell Jesus' disciples the news, Jesus met them. "Greetings!" Jesus said. The women fell at Jesus' feet and worshiped Him. "Don't be afraid," Jesus told them. "Go tell My brothers they will see Me in Galilee." Jesus is alive!





