READ a Bible STORYBOOK

Read a story about Jesus from an illustrated Bible storybook to your child. Point out Jesus and say His name as you turn each page. Mention that your child can see drawings of Jesus on the pages, but Thomas saw Jesus in real life! Tell the Bible story (reverse side). State: "Jesus is the Son of God. John 20:31." Pray, thanking God for sending Jesus.

Play "I SPY"

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Remind your child that Thomas used his eyes to see Jesus. Explain that you and your child will use your eyes to see different things in the room. Say: "I spy something (name a color)" and invite your child to guess what the object is. Give your child the opportunity to reciprocate if possible. State: "I spy the Bible." Open the Bible to John 20:31 and read the verse aloud.




MOVE with Your Baby

BABIES

Jesus appeared to His disciples (helpers) one day. They saw and touched Him—Jesus was alive!

The men were happy to see Jesus.

Thomas was not there that day. On another day, Thomas and the disciples (helpers) were together when Jesus appeared again. Thomas saw and touched Jesus. Thomas knew Jesus was alive.

Jesus did more miracles, and the men knew that Jesus is the Son of God.



One of the disciples, Thomas, was not in the room when Jesus came. When the other disciples told Thomas what had happened, Thomas did not believe them.


Eight days later, the disciples were in a locked room again. This time Thomas was with them. Suddenly, Jesus came and stood with the disciples.

Thomas Saw Jesus

JOHN 20:19-31

After Jesus died on the cross, the disciples were very afraid even though Mary Magdalene had told the disciples Jesus was alive, and they had seen the empty tomb.

Because the disciples were afraid of the Jews, they were meeting in a room with the door locked. The disciple named Thomas was not with them. Even



though the door was locked, Jesus was suddenly standing in the room with the disciples. Jesus said, "Peace be with you" and showed them the wounds on His hands and His side.

The disciples were so happy! They were excited to tell Thomas they had seen Jesus! But Thomas did not believe them. Thomas said if he did not see the marks on Jesus' hands himself or touch the wound on Jesus' side himself, he would never believe.

A week later, the disciples were back in the same room with the doors locked. This time Thomas was with them. Even though the doors were locked again, Jesus appeared in the room. Jesus looked at Thomas and spoke to him. Jesus asked Thomas to put his finger on His hand and touch His side so he would know it was really Him.

Thomas did not have to touch Jesus' side to believe, he immediately began to worship Jesus saying, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said that any people who believed in Him without seeing were blessed.

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





JOHN 20:19-31

Jesus is alive! On the same night His disciples heard that Jesus was alive, they gathered together in a secret place with the door securely locked. They were afraid of the people who had arrested and put Jesus to death.

Suddenly, Jesus was with them! "Peace be with you," Jesus said. He showed the disciples where His hands and His side were wounded when He was on the cross. The disciples



were very glad to see Jesus. Jesus explained that He wanted them to go and tell others. He promised to send the Holy Spirit to help them, and He told the disciples to forgive others.

Thomas, one of the disciples, was not with the group. The other disciples told Thomas, "We've seen the Lord," but Thomas didn't believe them.

Thomas said, "If I don't see and feel the marks that the nails made in His hands and touch His side, I will not believe it!"

A week later the disciples were together again. This time Thomas was with them. The door was locked, but that did not stop Jesus from coming and standing with the disciples. "Peace be with you," Jesus said to them.

Then Jesus went to Thomas. "Put your finger on My hands and look at them. Put your hand in My side. Believe in Me!"


Thomas realized that it was all true, and Jesus was alive! Thomas said, "My Lord and my God!"

Jesus answered Thomas, "You believe because you have seen Me for yourself. Blessed are those who haven't seen Me and still believe."


