Jesus Restored Peter

JOHN 18:15-18,25-27; 21:1-19

Jesus had been arrested and taken to Caiaphas, the high priest. (John 18:13-14) Peter, one of Jesus' disciples, followed Him there. When Peter entered the door into the high priest's courtyard, the doorkeeper asked him, "Aren't you one of Jesus' disciples?" But Peter answered the girl, "No, I am not."



While Peter was warming himself by a

fire in the courtyard, some other people asked him if he was one of Jesus' disciples. But again, Peter answered, "No, I am not." Then a servant announced that he had seen Peter with Jesus. Peter denied that was true. After that, a rooster crowed.

Many days later after Jesus died on the cross and God raised Him from the dead, Peter and the disciples went fishing. They fished all night but caught nothing. Early that morning, someone standing on the shore told the men to throw their nets on the right side of the boat. When the disciples did that, they caught many fish. 




