After the man prayed and broke bread, the two men saw that He was Jesus. The men went back to Jerusalem to tell that Jesus was alive.

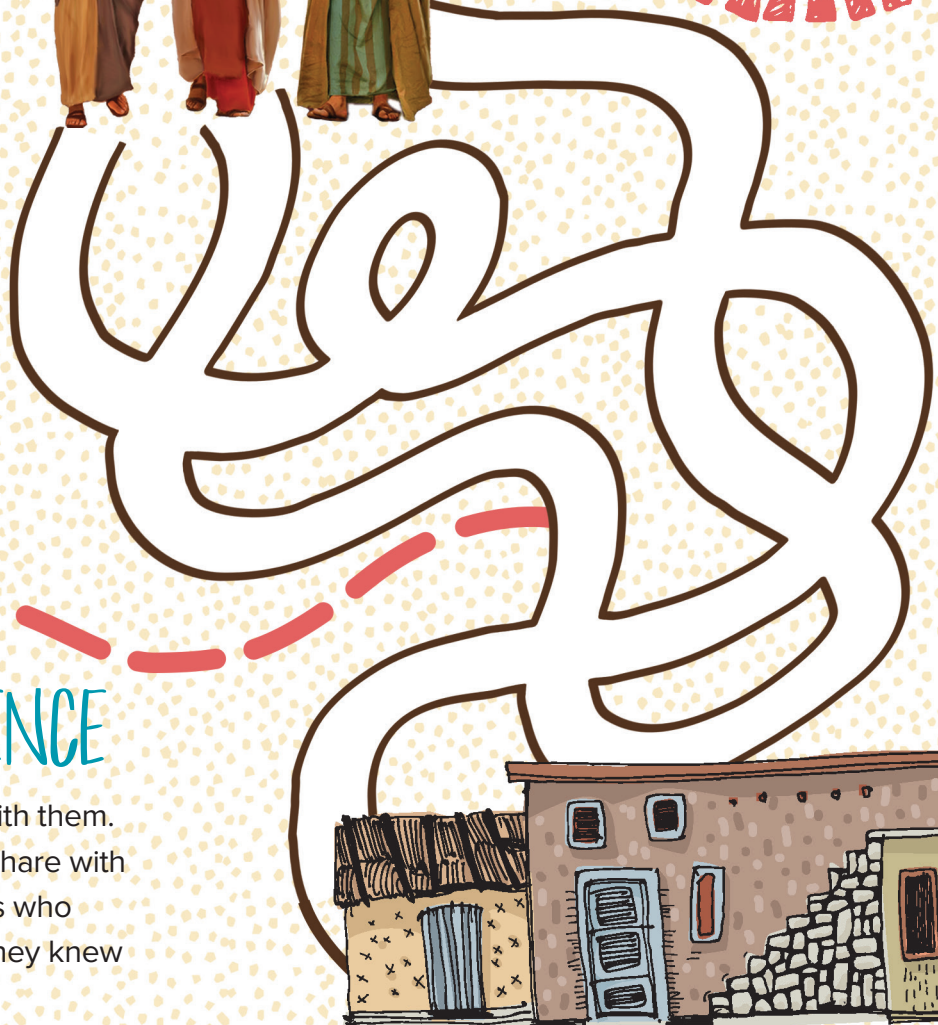

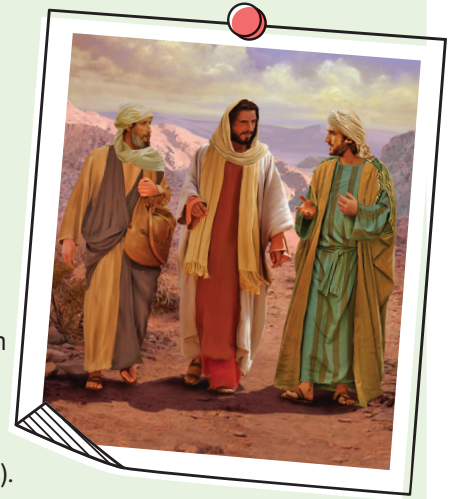
## CONVERSATION

### Jesus Taught Two Men

**BASED ON LUKE 24:13-35**

**WEEKLY VERSE:** Jesus told the men what the Bible said. *Luke 24:27*

**LIFE POINT:** Jesus helped people learn about Him. .



Two men walked to a town near Jerusalem called Emmaus (eh MAY uhs). The men were talking and arguing about what had happened the past week.

As they walked, a man joined them. This man was Jesus, but the men did not know it was Jesus. Jesus asked the men why they were arguing. The men told Jesus what had happened the past few days. They said, “Jesus did many miracles. We thought He was the person that the prophets said would come. But Jesus died on a cross. Now, three days later, some women went to the tomb where He was buried. It was empty. An angel told them that Jesus was alive!”

Jesus told the men what the Bible said. He reminded them of things the Bible said about Him. When they neared Emmaus, the men asked Him to stay with them. He did. They sat down to eat. Jesus took bread, prayed over it, and tore it to share with the men. Suddenly, the men understood that Jesus was sitting at their table!

The men returned to Jerusalem that night to find Jesus’ disciples (helpers). They told the disciples they had seen Jesus. He is alive!

### Jesus Returned to Heaven

#### ACTS 1:4-11

After Jesus died on the cross and came back to life, He spent 40 days with the disciples, talking with them and teaching them.

Finally Jesus was ready to leave and go to heaven. Jesus asked the disciples to stay in Jerusalem and wait for the Holy Spirit to come. God had promised to send the Holy Spirit so the disciples would not be alone after Jesus left them.

The disciples asked Jesus when He would come back as King. Jesus told them they could not know the time.

Jesus said the Holy Spirit would come, help the disciples, and guide them so they could do God's work on earth. The Holy Spirit would help the disciples tell people how Jesus died and came back to life. Because the disciples had seen Jesus, people could know about Jesus in every city and country, all over the world.

After Jesus talked about the Holy Spirit, the disciples watched as Jesus was taken up into the air. While He was going out of their sight into the clouds, suddenly two men in white clothes were standing by them. The men asked the disciples why they were looking up. They said Jesus would be coming back some day, the same way He left.

### Jesus Returned to Heaven

**ACTS 1:4-11**

At the end of the time Jesus spent on earth after His resurrection, Jesus told the disciples to stay in Jerusalem because He was going to send them the gift that God promised to them, the Holy Spirit.

The disciples asked Jesus what else would happen in the future.

Jesus told them that only God knows the time of things that will happen

in the future. He told the disciples that the Holy Spirit would help them to do God's work so that the good news of Jesus could be heard by people everywhere.

After He said these things, Jesus was taken up into the sky. A cloud took Him out of their sight. The disciples watched, looking up as Jesus returned to heaven. 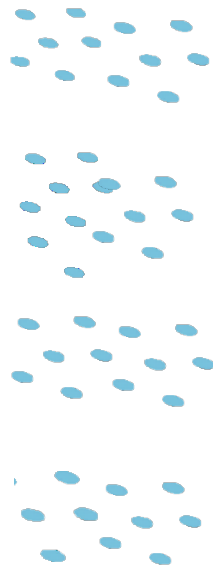
