

BASED ON ACTS 2:1-42

WEEKLY VERSE: We tell that God sent Jesus for all the world. 1 John 4:14

LIFE POINT: People tell others about Jesus.

Peter and the other disciples (helpers) of Jesus were together in a house. They heard a sound like a strong wind. People gathered outside the house after hearing the sound.

The disciples began to speak in different languages. They went out to tell the people about Jesus. The people were surprised that the disciples could speak in many languages.

Peter Preached About Jesus

ACTS 2:1-42

All the people were together in Jerusalem for a special holiday. Peter and Jesus' other disciples were together in a house.

Suddenly there was a loud sound like a very strongly blowing wind. It filled the whole house where the disciples were staying. At the same time, it looked like there was fire over each disciple's head!

All the disciples started talking. The people were amazed because they could hear them speaking in different languages. "What is this?" the people wondered.








CONVERSATION

Peter Preached at Pentecost

ACTS 2:1-42

Fifty days after Passover, many people were in Jerusalem to celebrate another feast called Pentecost. Peter, the other disciples, and other believers were together in one place. Jesus had already gone back to heaven. On the day of Pentecost, the sound of a strong wind from God rushed into the house. Suddenly flames of fire appeared over the heads of each believer. The believers were all filled with God's Holy Spirit and began to speak in languages they had not known before!



The crowd that had come to Jerusalem for the feast included people from nations near and far. When they heard the sound of the wind and the people talking, they hurried to find out what was going on.

They discovered that each of them could hear the believers speaking in the listeners' languages! They realized these believers were speaking a language God helped them know!

The listeners were amazed. They asked, "What does this mean?" Peter spoke to the crowd: "These people are doing what the prophet wrote in the Scriptures. He said that God would one day pour His Spirit on men, women, and servants to tell others great wonders."

Peter reminded the crowd that they themselves had seen Jesus do miracles and wonders, but had also then helped put Jesus to death. He reminded them that Jesus came back to life.

The people began to ask, "What shall we do?"

Peter answered: "Repent. Be baptized in the name of Jesus for the forgiveness of your sins. You will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

That day 3,000 people trusted Jesus and were baptized.

Every day after that, the believers met together to learn from the disciples. They worshiped, ate, and prayed together. They trusted Jesus.

LIFE POINT: All people need to hear that Jesus is the Savior.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE



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

have spelled three more words. You may not move diagonally.



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LEVEL OF BIBLICAL LEARNING

Even before they are born, people are special to God.




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ACTS 2:1-42

On a special day called Pentecost, Jesus' followers were together in one place. Suddenly, a sound like wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were staying. The Holy Spirit came to the believers like fiery flames and rested on them. When that happened, the believers were able to speak in different languages.

Travelers from all over were in the city of Jerusalem. They were faithful men from every nation under heaven. When they heard these sounds, a crowd gathered.



The people were confused because each person heard the disciples speaking in his own language. "How can this be?" they asked.

Some people made fun of the disciples and laughed at them.

Peter stood up and said, "Pay attention! These people are doing what the prophets predicted. You allowed evil people to nail Jesus to a cross and kill Him, but God raised Jesus from the grave. We are all witnesses of this, for we have seen Him! So let all of Israel know that God has made Jesus—the One you crucified—both Lord and Messiah!"

When the people heard this, they became upset and were filled with guilt. They asked Peter and the disciples, "What should we do?"

Peter said, "Confess your sins and turn away from them. Each of you must be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Those who believed Peter's message believed Jesus was the Savior and were baptized. That day about 3,000 people were added to the believers and formed the first church. They listened and learned all that the disciples taught. They gathered with other believers every day to eat together and pray.



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
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
