Call a FAMILY MEMBER

Look at the Bible story picture (reverse side). Say the names of the first family: Adam, Eve, Cain, and Abel. Say that this was the first family. Encourage your child to name people in your family. Talk about things you like to do with your family. Suggest your child phone a family member. Guide him to tell the person that God created families.

Look at FAMILY PICTURES

Encourage your child to sit with you and look at pictures of people in your family. Talk about who each person is. Mention that God made families and He has a plan for them. Remind your child that the people in the first family were Adam, Eve, Cain, and Abel. Pray with your child, thanking God for families.

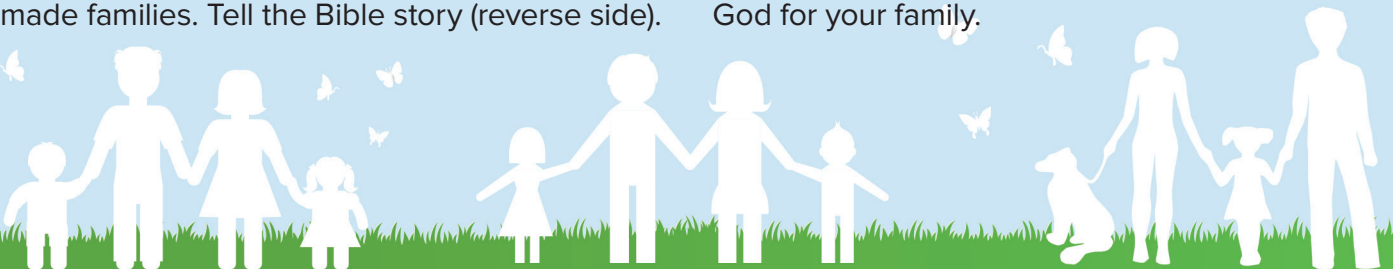
BABIES

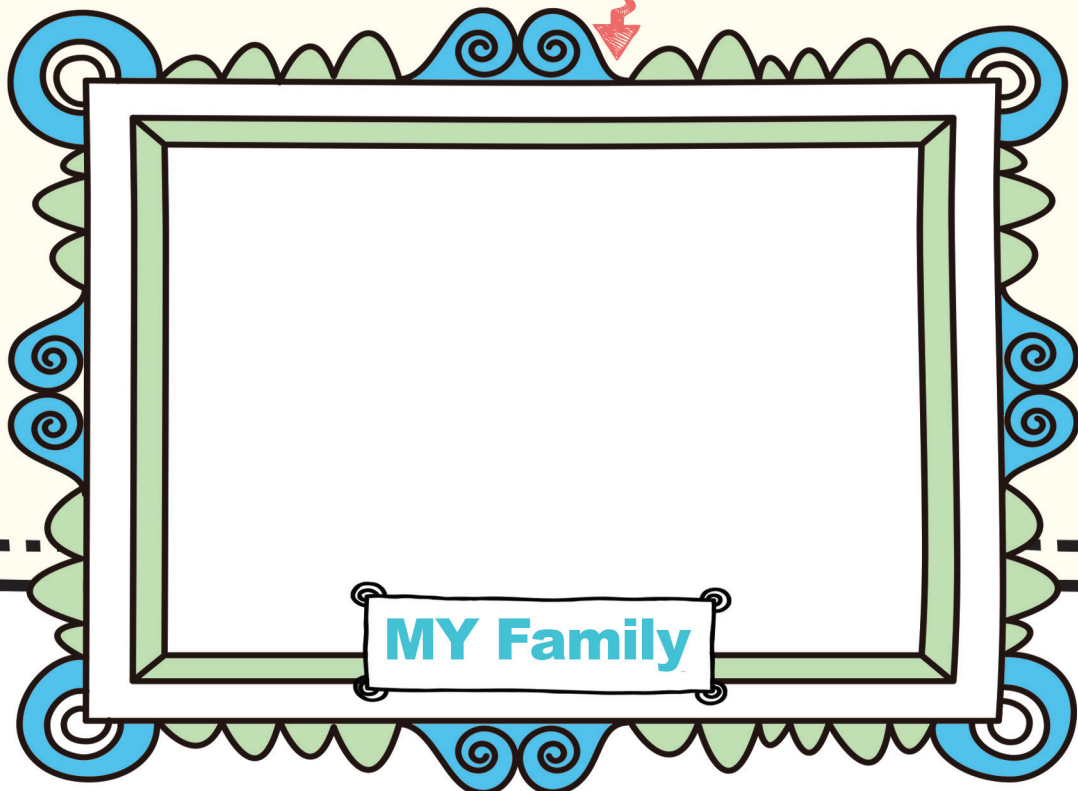

Isaac and Rebekah

GENESIS 24

Abraham was very old, and he wanted to find a wife for his son, Isaac. Abraham sent for his trusted servant and said, “Promise that you will go to my homeland and my own people to find a wife for my son, Isaac. God will help you find the right woman there.”

Abraham’s servant and his helpers packed many supplies for the journey. They set out on 10 camels and traveled to Abraham’s homeland. When the servant arrived, it was evening—the time of day when the women came to the well to draw water.

Abraham’s servant made the camels kneel beside the well. Then he prayed. “God of my master Abraham,” he said, “give me success. I will ask one of the young women of the town for a drink from her water jug. If she says, ‘Take a drink, and I will also water your camels,’ I will know this is the woman You have chosen for Isaac.”

While the servant was still praying, along came Rebekah, a beautiful young woman, balancing a water jug on her shoulder. As Rebekah filled her jug, Abraham’s servant ran to her. “Please let me have a drink of water,” he said.

“Have a drink,” Rebekah replied, “and I will draw water for your camels until they have had all they need to drink.” She emptied her jug into the trough again and again until the camels drank as much as they wanted.

Abraham’s servant took a gold ring and two gold bracelets from his pack. “Whose daughter are you?” he asked. “Is there room for us to spend the night?”

Rebekah told him that she came from Abraham’s family. “We have plenty of straw and feed and space for you to stay with us.”

Abraham’s servant bowed and worshiped God. “Praise the Lord!” he exclaimed. “He has shown kindness to my master and me. He led me to the house of my master’s relatives.” He met Rebekah’s family and explained why he had come.
